In 2-wheel drive, the Eagle Wagon gives the kind of economy* you want in and around town. The Select Drive control on the Eagle instrument panel is positioned for easy reach of the driver. To select a different driving mode, simply stop the vehicle, move the switch to the opposite side and proceed. It's that simple: 2-wheel drive to the left for fuel efficiency,* 4-wheel drive to the right for extra traction and security.

HOW IT WORKS.

NEW I-FOUR ENGINE.

The new Eagle I-4 is an inline OHV design, the classic configuration for light-duty 4WD applications. All major engine functions are microprocessor controlled including spark, fuel, air injection (pulse air) and carburetion. A unique built-in knock sensor allows the microprocessor to measure knock at each cylinder as it fires, computing in milliseconds which cylinder is affected, then automatically retarding spark to protect each

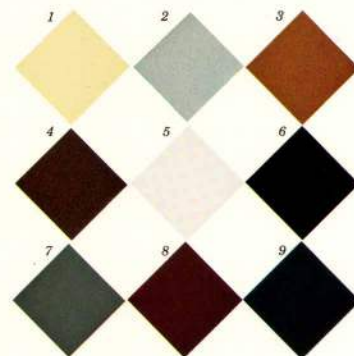
WARRANTY HIGHLIGHTS

All 1984 Eagle vehicles are covered by the 1984 Full New Vehicle Warranty that provides for 12-months/12,000-miles of coverage on all components except tires which are covered under a separate tire manufacturer's warranty.

Upon expiration of the new vehicle warranty, a number of specified engine, trans-

mission, transfer case and front or rear wheel drive components are covered against defects for an additional 12-month/12,000-miles. This 1984 Eagle Extended Powertrain Protection Limited Warranty requires the owner to pay the first \$100 per repair visit for the repair or replacement of any covered items.
