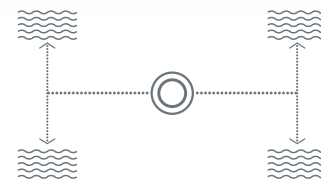

.05 – Electronic Stability Control

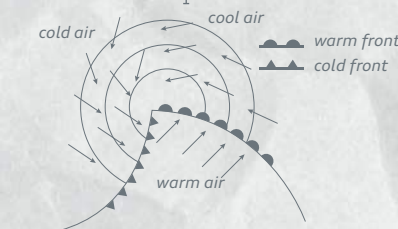

Unlock your mobile phone's potential through the MMI system. Simply pair them up and start enjoying near complete control at the touch of a button.³

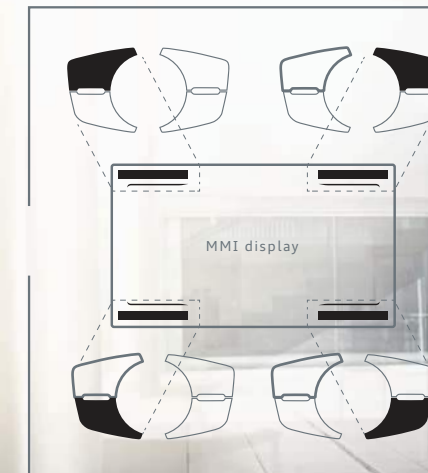

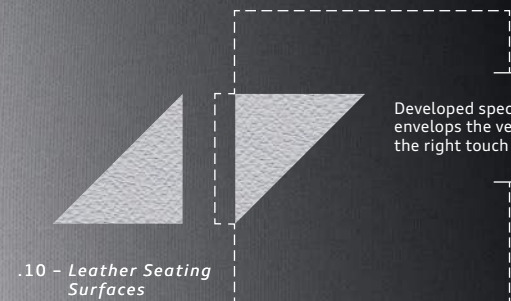

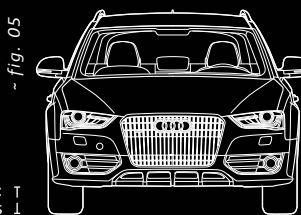


11 - Base Carrier Bars
