

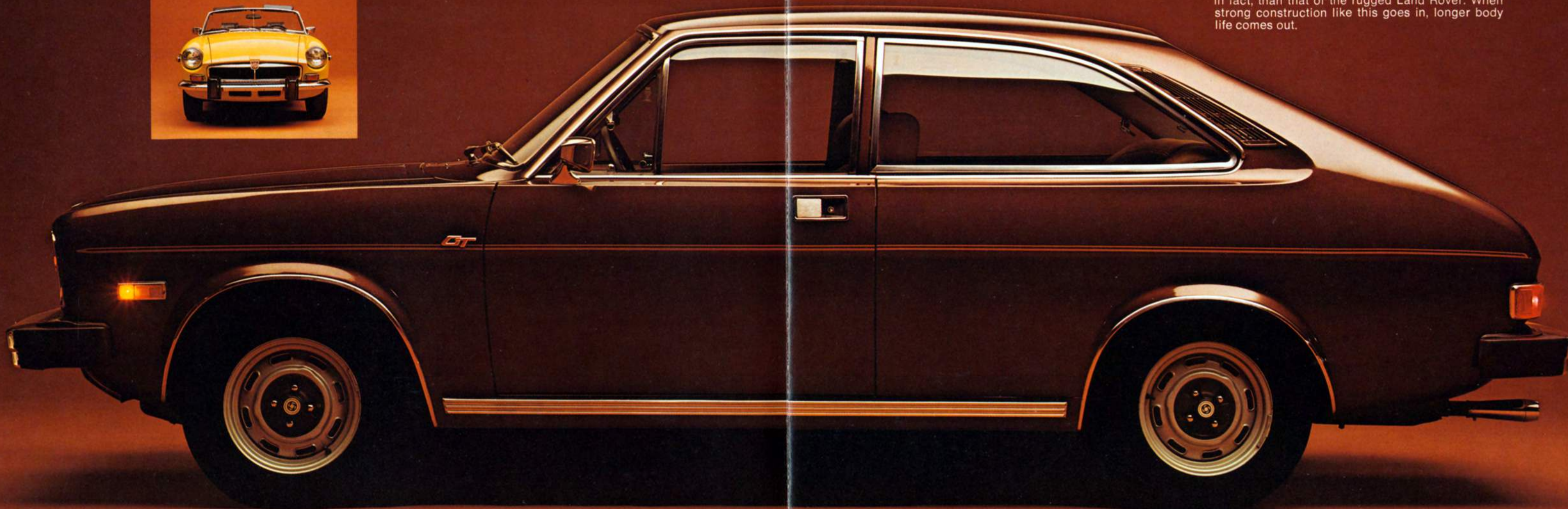


**The Gas-Saving Marina.

What's more, the Marina's long-life good looks are assured by a seven-stage phosphating process, extensive electroplating of anti-corrosive agents and the application of heavy-duty under-sealants.

Or the practical Marina sedan with rear door locks that can be adjusted so children cannot accidentally open them. 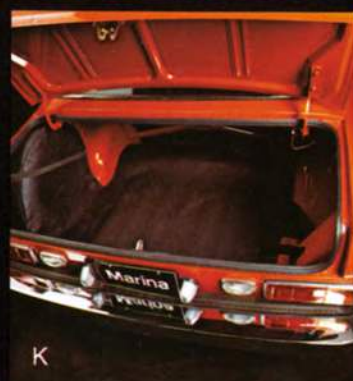

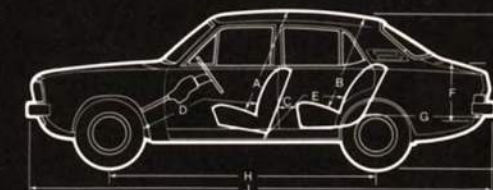
- (A) Easy-to-read instrumentation clustered in a padded dash.
