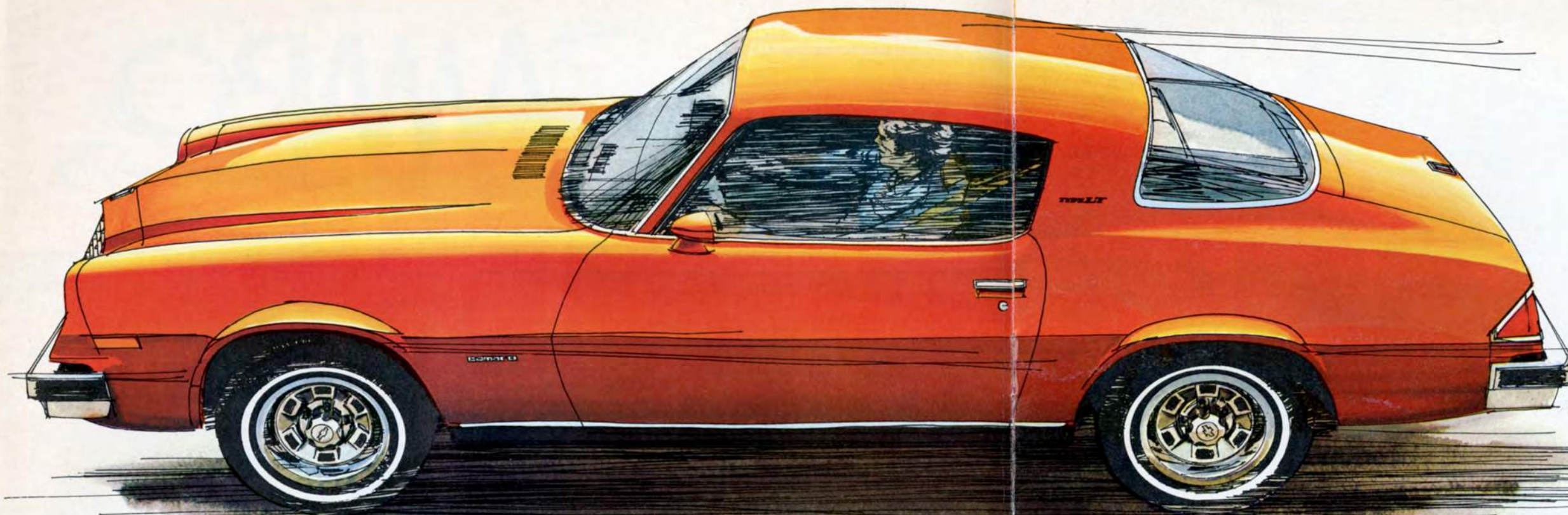

Transmissions

A floor-mounted 3-Speed manual transmission is standard on all Camaros. A floor-mounted 4-Speed manual wide-range is available with the 350-4 barrel V8. Turbo Hydra-matic is available for all models.

Axle Ratios

A new 2.56:1 Highway Axle Ratio is available this year. Four other ratios ranging up to 3.73:1 are offered with various engine/transmission combinations. Standard ratio is 2.73:1. Your dealer will gladly advise as to availability and suitability to your needs.

Thanks to Chevrolet's new Efficiency System, the 1975 Camaro is designed to run leaner (more economically), run cleaner (meet new emission standards) and save you money every mile. It goes farther between recommended

tune-ups, oil changes, lube jobs and spark plug replacements.

The system includes GM-Specification steel-belted radial tires as standard equipment on both models, High Energy Ignition, catalytic converter and other improvements shown and described on page 5.

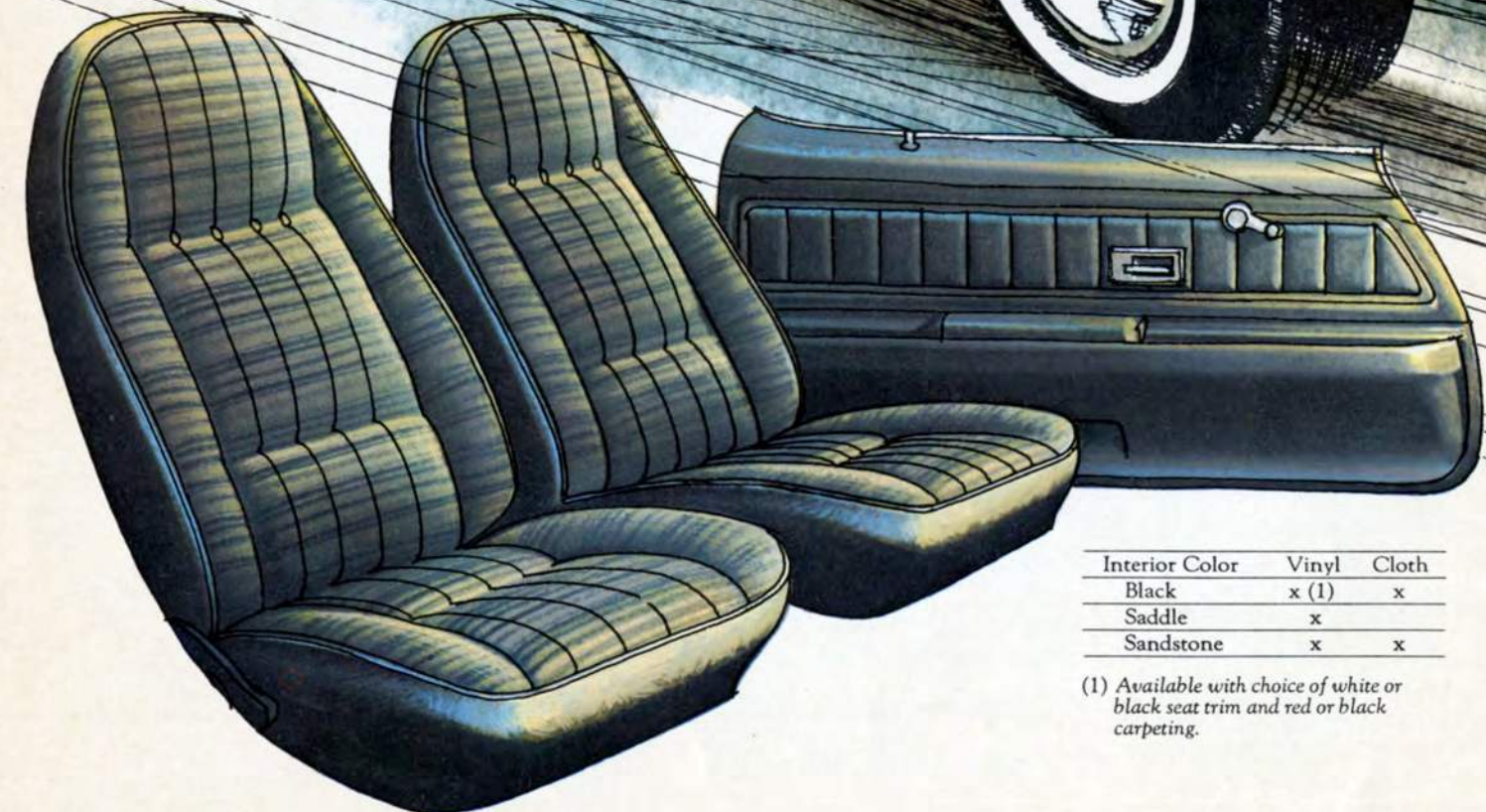
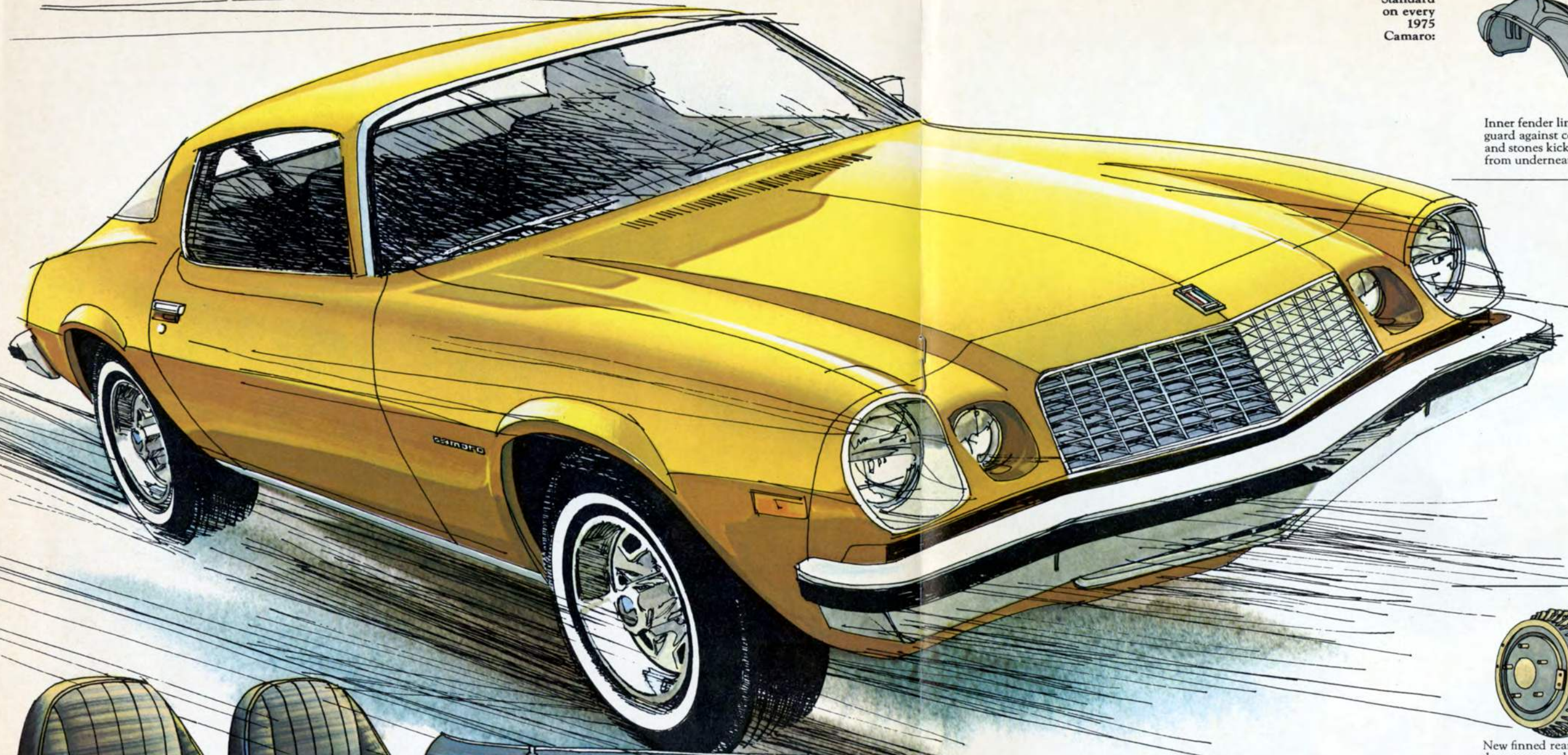

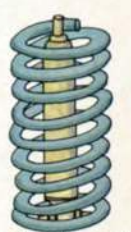
Inner fender liners help guard against corrosion and stones kicked up from underneath.



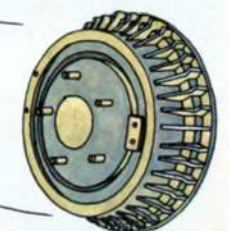
Sport steering wheel adds to the feeling that you've got a sports car in your hands.

Front coil and rear leaf springs are computer-selected to fit the weight of the car as equipped.



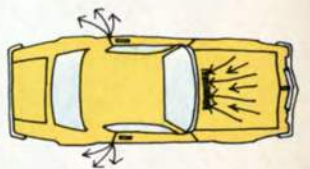
New finned rear brake drums run cooler, resist fade.

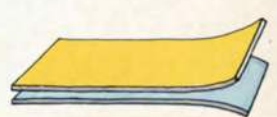

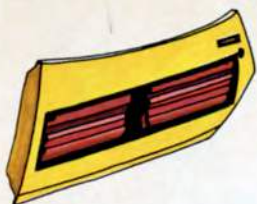
Power ventilation system constantly replaces air in the car with ignition on, even when it's standing still.

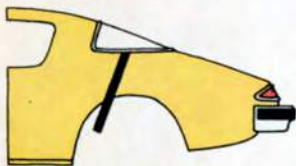
Coolant recovery system helps prevent coolant loss and overheating.

*High Energy Ignition (HEI) produces up to 85% hotter spark for quick starts. No points or ignition condenser to replace.



*Revamped 6-cylinder engine is smoother running and more responsive than before. (Not avail. on LT.)



*Carburetor air intake extension brings in cooler outside air to help improve performance.



*Early Fuel Evaporation system speeds up engine warm-up by using exhaust gases to heat incoming fuel-air mixture.



*Tough GM-Specification steel-belted radial ply tires for good traction, durability and improved gas mileage.



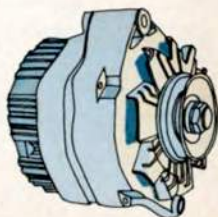

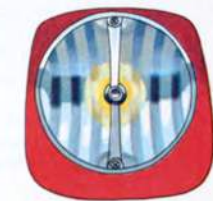
Sport mirrors on both sides. Driver's is remote-controlled.
