Malibu's standard 170-hp 3100 V6 engine combines with an electronically controlled, four-speed automatic transmission to deliver abundant power for passing or merging into traffic. This V6 also sips gas like a four-cylinder. (EPA estimated MPG 20 city, 29 highway.)

Malibu's Standard Safety/Security Package Gives You That Confident Feeling.

The standard safety package in the 2001 Chevy Malibu is both advanced and comprehensive. It includes a high-strength steel safety cage around the passenger compartment, plus energy-absorbing front and rear crush zones. Malibu also has dual air bags and a four-wheel antilock brake system (ABS). For added safety during daylight hours, Daytime Running Lamps come on automatically at a reduced intensity to make your Malibu more visible to drivers of oncoming vehicles. Every time you get into your new Malibu, you'll feel confident and secure with this comprehensive safety package surrounding you.

A NOTE ON CHILD SAFETY:

Always use safety belts and proper child restraints, even with air bags. Children are safer when properly secured in a rear seat. Never place a rear-facing infant restraint in the front seat of any vehicle equipped with an active air bag. See your vehicle Owner's Manual and child safety seat instructions for more safety information.

A Standard Child Security Package.

This five-feature package (1) locates the fold-down seat* latch in the trunk, rather than inside the passenger compartment, so a child can't fold down the rear seat and get into the trunk; (2) requires the ignition to be on before the trunk release button in the car will function; (3) allows you to lock out the rear power window switches;* (4) provides top-tether anchors in the area behind each rear-seat position to better secure child restraint safety seats with top-tether straps; and (5) provides outboard rear safety belts which cinch for secure installation of child safety seats.

NOTE: A glow-in-the-dark trunk-lid release lever located inside the trunk compartment as a dealer-installed option can help keep children from locking themselves inside the trunk. Included in this option are a child-resistant outside trunk latch that requires presetting and a lockout strap positioned across the trunk pass-through. *If your Malibu is so equipped.

Standard Four-Wheel Antilock Brakes

ABS is standard in every 2001 Chevy Malibu. You'd pay hundreds of dollars for an ABS option in many other midsize cars.*

All Around You—A Quality Package.

Insulated Interior

Engine and road noise are reduced, thanks to a thick floorboard pad and generous use of dampening materials in the floor and rear-window area.

Dampening Baffles In The Floor, Rockers, Body And Pillars

The extensive use of acoustic materials in all these areas helps make Malibu a quiet car.

Rear-Window Defogger

This zoned rear-window defogger is thoughtfully designed to clear the center of the rear window first.

All-Aluminum Front Brake Calipers

They reduce weight by 20 percent (with aluminum pistons) vs. conventional systems. Audible wear sensors for front disc brake pads are standard. Non-asbestos material is used for front pads and rear shoes.

Galvanized-Steel Body

Malibu body panels are made of two-sided galvanized steel for excellent protection against corrosion. The zinc coating helps prevent exterior surface rust due to minor chips and scratches, and helps prevent holes which could start from the inside.

Liquid-Filled Engine Mounts

The Malibu engine floats on hydraulic mounts. This system actually tunes certain engine noises to levels inaudible to the human ear.

Noise-Reducing Steering Gear

Malibu has isolated inner tie rods that reduce the transfer of road noise and vibration into the passenger compartment.

No Timing Adjustments — Ever

A direct ignition system eliminates the need for periodic engine timing adjustments.*

Recessed Windshield Wipers

The windshield wipers "park" well below the airstream, which helps reduce wind noise caused by air turbulence at highway speeds.

Front Chassis Frame

The front chassis frame design helps deliver a pleasing, responsive driving experience while contributing to occupant safety. It is a robust, structurally rigid design.

Solar-Ray Tinted Glass

The windshield and rear window are made of Solar-Ray tinted glass, which helps decrease the sun's glare inside the car.

Integral Rain Gutter

A "roof ditch molding" is designed to help keep you dry when you enter or exit your Malibu on rainy days.

Frame-Under-Glass Door Design

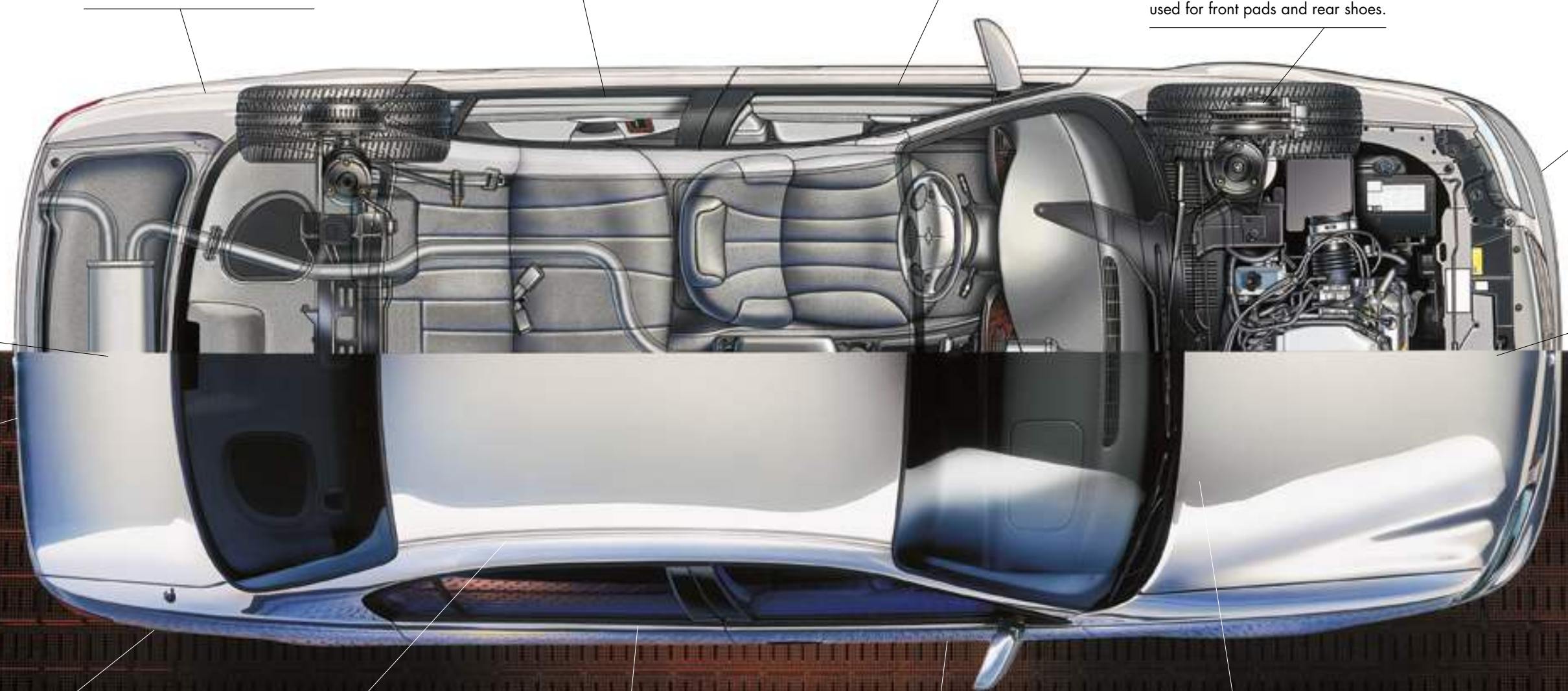
This design contributes to reduced wind noise at highway speeds. A specially designed radio antenna and sculpted mirrors add to a quiet ride.

Stainless-Steel Exhaust System

The muffler and tailpipe are made of aluminized stainless steel — and the take-down pipe, extension pipe and catalytic converter shell are made of stainless steel — providing excellent corrosion protection for the entire exhaust system.

A Quality Paint Process

Body panels are made of two-sided galvanized steel and "heal" themselves when scratched. They get a phosphate coating and rust-fighting primer, topped by a glass-smooth primer surfacer. After the basecoat goes on, a clearcoat provides a durable shine.

Malibu's new RDS-capable audio system has technology that allows you to receive a wide variety of information, including a radio station's format (e.g., rock, jazz, talk), text messages, and important traffic alerts or weather bulletins. This new stereo also retains power for 10 minutes after you turn off the ignition or until a door is opened, to let you finish listening to a newscast or favorite song. What's more, the key fob that activates your Remote Keyless Entry system can be programmed to reset the station preferences of two different drivers while the car is being unlocked.

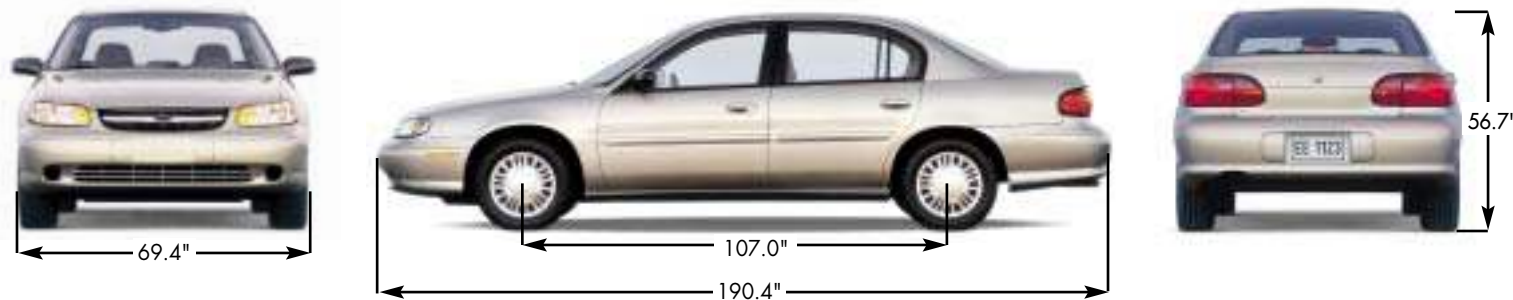
