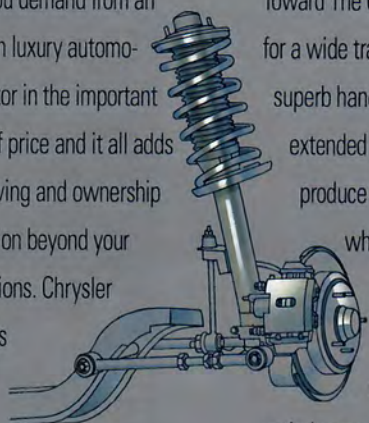


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CHRYSLER LHS

the lexicon of automotive engineering.

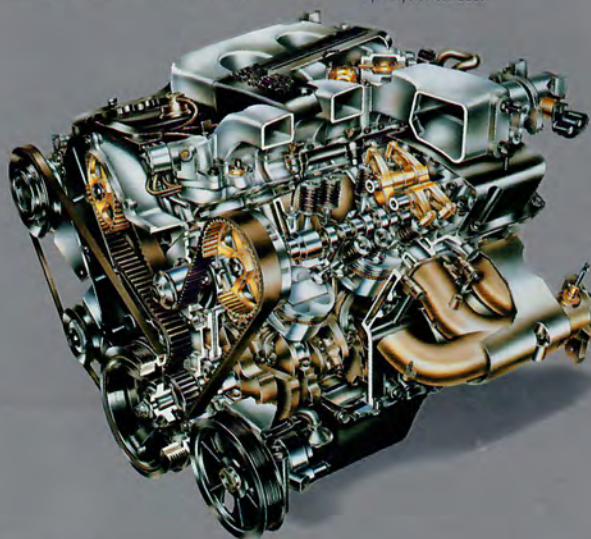

Cab-Forward rakes the windshield, moving its base far forward to expand interior volume, which also aids aerodynamics to a startling degree. Wheels Toward The Corners makes for a wide track, hence superb handling, and an extended wheelbase to produce a between the wheels, "cradle" ride. Something words cannot describe is an entirely new driving experience. The fully independent front and rear suspension is but one reason LHS is so road-worthy. It provides a supple, compliant ride and superb cornering adhesion. The LHS

reflects a Chrysler engineering guideline: M&M — Maximum space for Man, Minimum for Machine. The same aerodynamics, for example, that lowers the hoodline also compresses the overall area of the engine compartment.

Chrysler engineers responded with an all-new engine to fit perfectly, the 3.5-liter, 24-valve OHC V6 that delivers 214 horsepower. A high-output performance engine, it is strong, smooth, responsive, and clean-burning. On the road, it's clear within the first mile that this is a sedan with exceptional ride and handling

quality, one with an impressive interior featuring leather-faced seating that coddles driver and passengers. Interior air management, for example, is sufficient to chill a 1,500-square foot house, but with infinitely greater precision. Preselected temperatures are electronically confirmed once each second, with 23 settings. The new Chrysler LHS. It's the first five-passenger sedan to encapsulate three heretofore mutually exclusive elements: Uncommon interior room and comfort. Superb handling. And style and luxury in the contemporary idiom.
