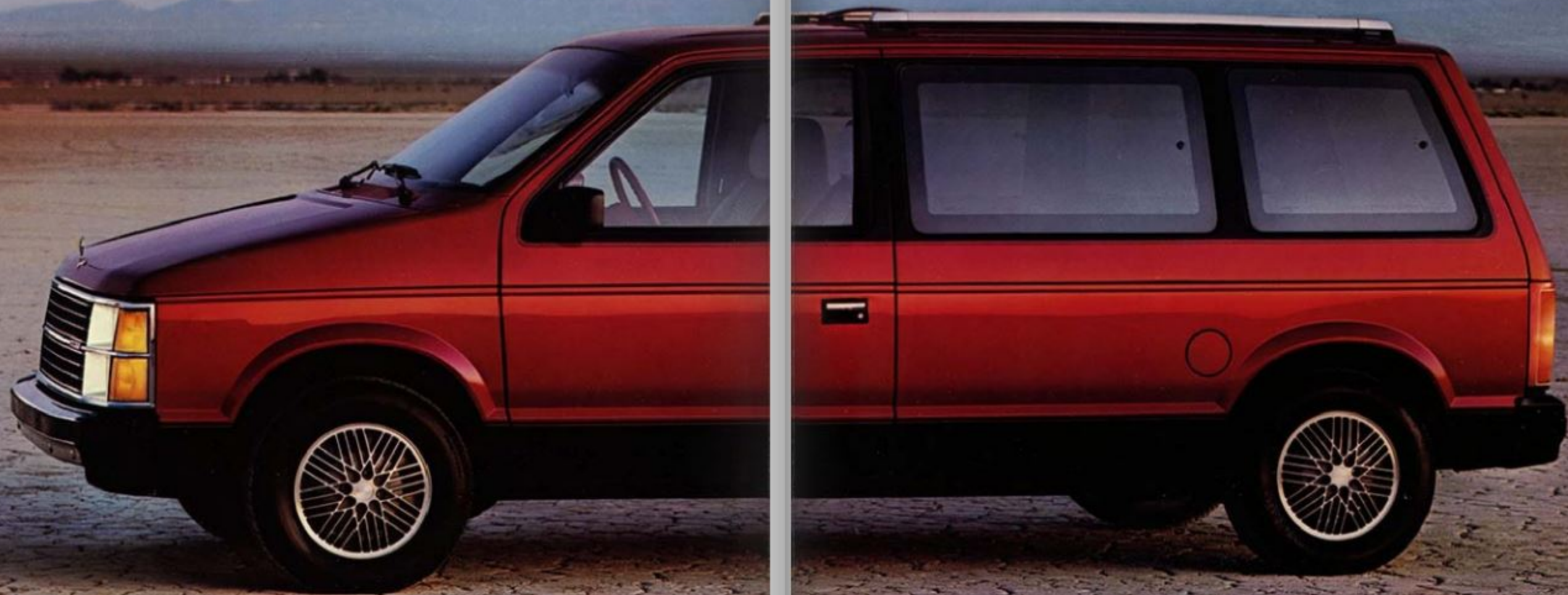

In its creation of the Caravan, Dodge set out to put the most interior space into the smallest possible exterior form. Very early it became evident that front-wheel design was the way to go. With the engine and trans-axle mounted forward in a single compact package, FWD gives the designer great freedom. The result is a flat, low floor, without sacrifice of

head room, that gives most passengers a surprisingly comfortable interior walk-through clearance of 47.6 inches. Unibody construction allows even further reduction in overall height and weight. A lightweight, smooth riding, strong vehicle with seating comfort for up to seven people. As agile and quick as a sedan, Caravan can be parked, garaged and run

through a car wash just as easily as a car. And best of all, it's affordable.

Five-year/50,000-mile limited warranty at no extra cost.

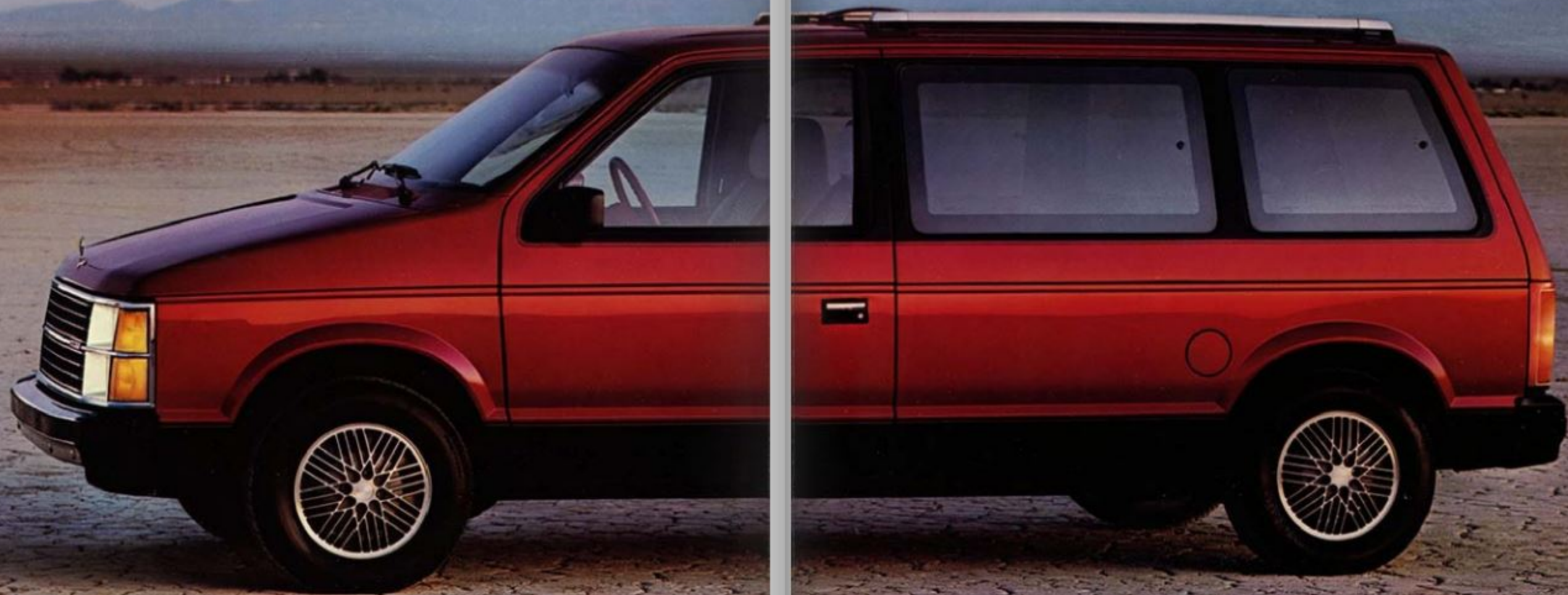

Standard interior features low-back cloth-trimmed front bucket seats. Deluxe color-keyed seat belts are standard and so is full-length passenger

Caravan offers three levels of personal interior luxury: the standard Caravan interior, the S.E. and the L.E. models.

Choose either high- or low-back front buckets and standard five-passenger or optional seven-passenger seating. Thoughtful convenience touches include an instrument panel storage bin, and a lockable storage drawer (larger than any glove box) with removable divider, under the front passenger seat. In addition to all of this,

Caravan offers standard power steering and power brakes to enhance your driving pleasure. As you can see, Caravan is quite complete. As comfortable and well outfitted as a luxury car, it also offers an outstanding blend of front-wheel drive ride, style and control.

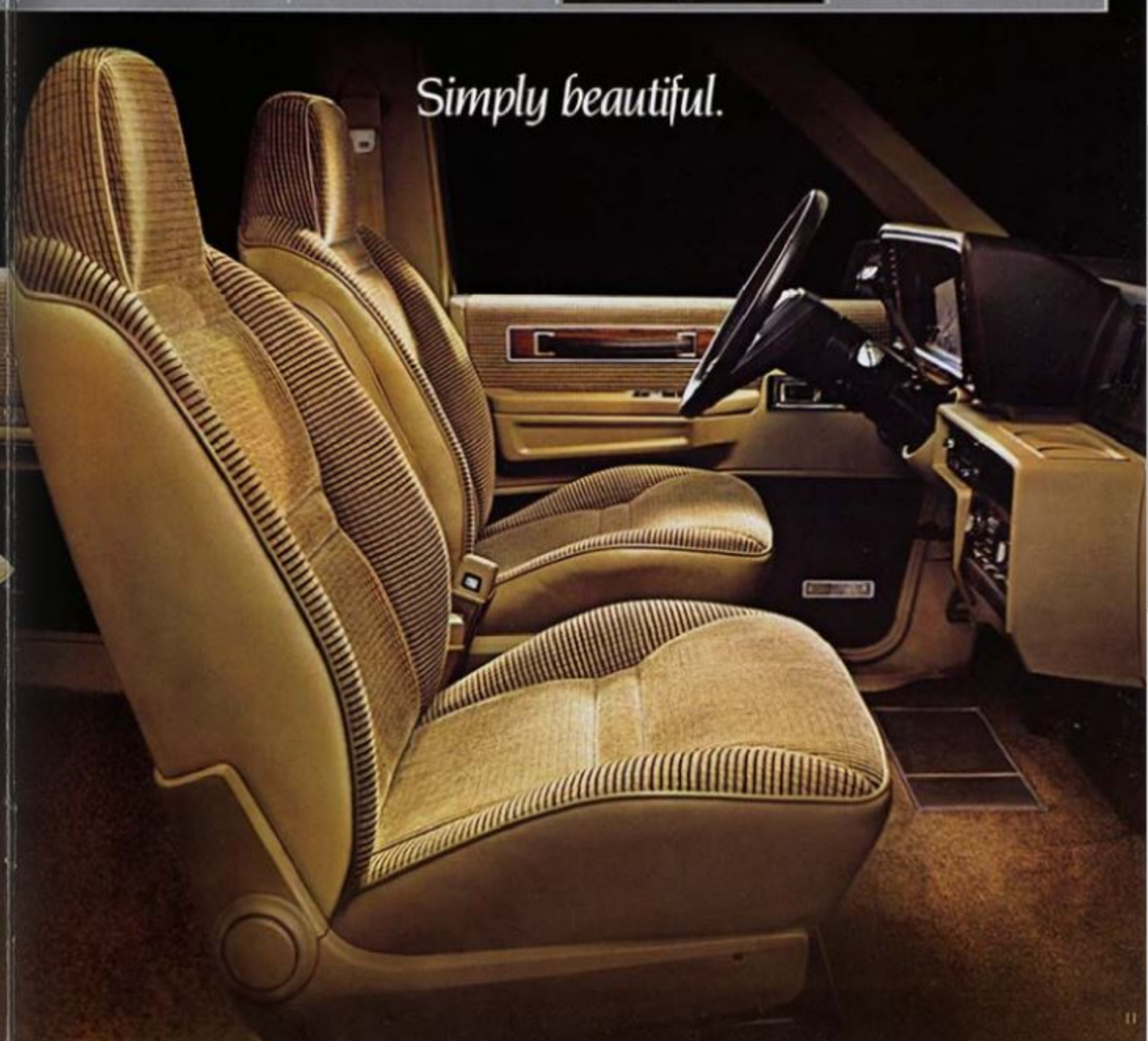

Space efficiency is the key to Caravan's uniqueness. Convenience is the key to Caravan's liveability. Everything about it says "enjoy." Wherever you sit in Caravan, you are but inches away from an easy-exit door. The sliding side door can be opened in the tightest quarters and with a minimum of effort. Caravan differs from any other station wagon you've ever known because it has a full 47.6 inches

of space from floor to ceiling. Four flip-out rear side windows contribute to flow-through ventilation. Tinted glass is standard, as is a shaded upper windshield for reduced glare.

For even greater sun protection, darker sun screen glass is available for the rear side and liftgate windows.

The thoroughness of Caravan's design can be demonstrated in the attention to

detail in the construction of the optional rear seat. The seatback can be folded forward into a locked horizontal position to provide extra cargo capacity. The hard, molded plastic seatback provides a handy durable surface for still more cargo storage. The seat also locks in an upright position. Its adjustable track arrangement permits 6 1/2-inch front-to-rear seat travel, with three locking positions. And its

quick-release mechanism permits seat removal in a jiffy.

Open a door, any door, and all interior lights go on, front and rear. With the optional Light Package you get two floodlights on the liftgate to illuminate the rear interior and exterior loading area. Front map reading lamps with individual controls are part of the Light Package, too.

And because Dodge wants your Caravan to last, they have

gone to great lengths to protect Caravan from the effects of corrosion. Caravan body panels are stamped from corrosion-resistant galvanized or specially treated electro-coated steels. And not just the critical areas, but the entire body—inside and out.

Along with its high quality construction, fun-to-drive attitude, and ease of handling, Caravan's an ideal vehicle for



families on the go. The simplicity of front-wheel drive makes it a system right for the times... and right for Caravan. Caravan's front-wheel drive concept set off a chain of engineering opportunities that permit the building of a more efficient vehicle than the conventional rear-wheel drive system many people are used to. Quality is top priority in the manufacture of Dodge cars and trucks. With the introduction of the front-wheel drive Omni in 1978, Dodge took a giant step forward in quality control. Because Dodge front-wheel drive vehicles, including Caravan, were designed from scratch, engineers and manufacturing technicians were freed from cumbersome traditional techniques. They had control over virtually every aspect of every detail of vehicle development. And their success is reflected in the extremely high degree of quality of Chrysler Corporation products.

Enter Caravan. Man and machine in perfect harmony.

Dodge used the most sophisticated automotive technology available in the creation of Caravan. Computers were used to design Caravan... to perfect its aerodynamic styling... to test its durability and reliability... and to aid in its manufacture. All Caravan bodies are constructed scientifically, using highly advanced computer-controlled automated welders for consistent and precise welds. Caravan's low profile allows easy entry and exit.

Quality is built into Chrysler's 2.2-liter four-cylinder overhead cam engine, too. Weighing only 293.8 pounds to help contribute to better efficiency.



Climate control.

You'd expect a high capacity climate control system in a 125-cubic foot interior, and that's just what Dodge gives you. In the vent or bi-level mode, air is delivered through five multi-directional outlets in the upper panel. Side demisters clear the side windows of moisture. And there's more. A special driver Ram Air vent for more fresh air. For absolute ventilation control, you may even specify a convenient driver or front passenger controlled remote vent system for the two rearmost side windows.



Convenience, anyone?

Serviceability is easy and convenient under the wide hood opening. And, as you might suspect, Caravan has storage room galore. The oversized storage compartment under the front passenger seat (shown at left, above) replaces the small glove box found on most cars. A cubby box on the dash can be used to store often used items such as maps, eyeglasses, and gloves. The convenient tray on top of the instrument panel is also standard. Inboard armrests and seatback recliners are stan-

dard on the L.E. front bucket seats. Handy storage pockets are also found on the backs of these L.E. front seats.

An AM radio with integral digital clock is standard. And it's not just any AM radio. This one is electronic, with touch tuning.

Quality ride

As we have said, Caravan is an all-new vehicle. Suspension system, chassis structure and interior appointments are all freshly designed. You ride smoothly thanks to Iso-Strut independent front suspension with coil springs and antisway bar. Single-stage multileaf rear springs and shock absorbers

With all their concern for quality and durability, you might guess that Dodge would offer Chrysler's exclusive Five-Year/50,000-Mile Protection Plan on Caravan. And you are right. Today new vehicle buyers often rank quality and durability first when considering a purchase. And the new Chrysler Corporation, as you probably know, is on the leading edge in responding to consumer concerns. The Five-Year/50,000-Mile Protection Plan is a limited warranty unmatched by Ford, General Motors, Datsun, Honda, or Toyota. It protects you against major repair costs for five years or 50,000 miles (whichever occurs first). The plan also provides for repair or replacement of any rust-perforated outer panel if the rusting occurred in use. Under the 5/50 Protection Plan, the owner is responsible for maintenance as specified in the Caravan owner's literature supplied with the vehicle. Fleet and lease vehicles are excluded. A deductible applies from the second through the fifth years. Your dealer will be happy to give you all the details of this superior protection plan.

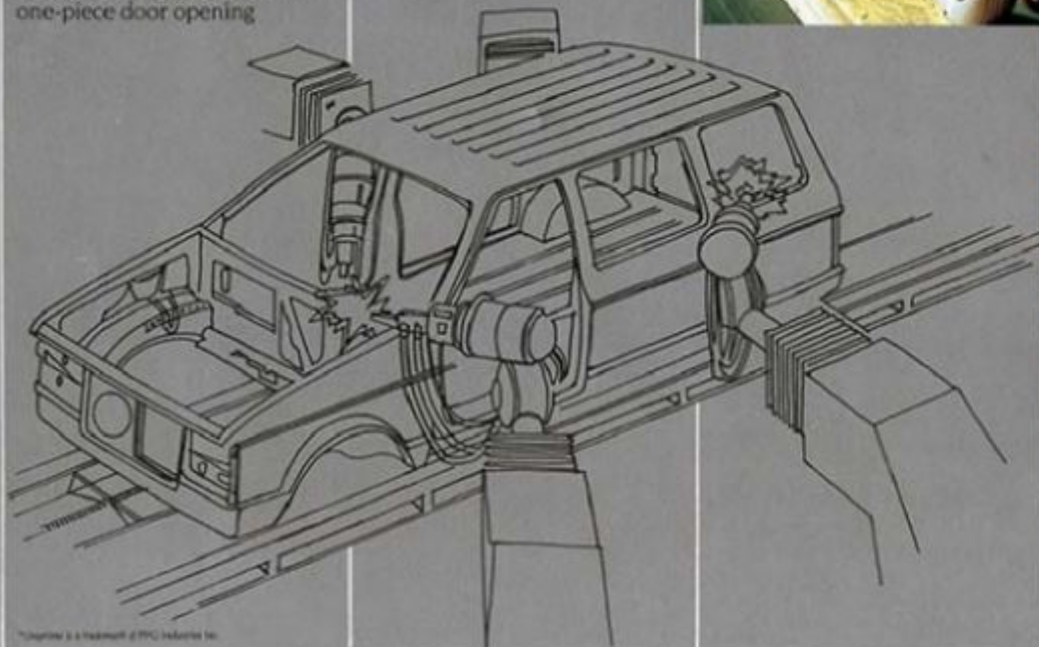


A revolution in high technology.

Caravan is built to last. Its body, with integral frame, features one-piece side panels for extra strength. Panels are stamped from corrosion-resistant, galvanized steel. A one-piece door opening

means a more precise door fit. Through the use of robotic welding, the entire body is assembled and welded as a single unit, utilizing aperture body panels rather than a multitude of pieces.

Dodge's new coating and painting technology is as modern as Caravan itself. Each Caravan body is fully submerged in a Uniprime® bath in which cathodic E-coat primer is applied. This enables even the hidden nooks and crannies throughout the body to be protected, not just the surfaces. The next step is the addition of a protective coating of urethane material to further

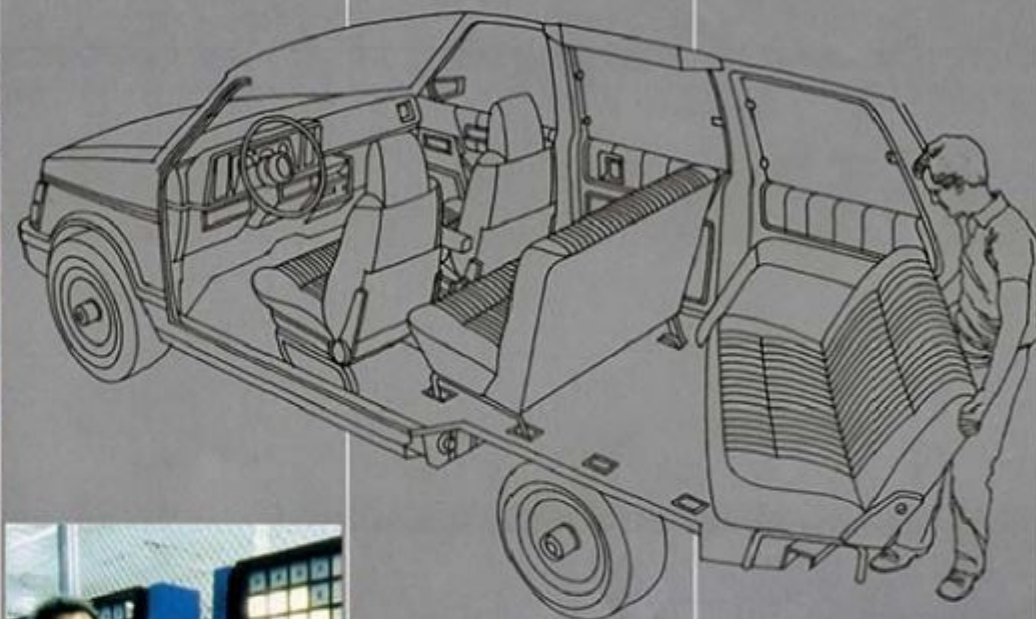
guard the body from corrosion and chip damage. It is applied to lower-body sill and wheelhouse areas.

To continue the protection, finish coats of high-solids

acrylic enamel are added, using state-of-the-art robotic sprayers. And last, but far from least, a clear topcoat is added to all colors for final protection and to heighten paint sheen. That's quality. That's protection. That's Caravan from Dodge for 1984.

Trim exterior dimensions, precise rack-and-pinion steering, and excellent visibility all around help make Caravan maneuverable, garageable and easy to park.

Caravan is built to accommodate people. Lots of them. Behind the two front individual bucket seats, the standard wagon has a three-passenger bench seat. The Seven-Passenger Seating Package provides a two-passenger bench seat in



the middle, and a three-passenger folding seat in the rear. Both bench seats are removable. With seats removed, you have an easy-access cargo area of almost seven feet by four feet. Caravan's uniqueness is a result of Chrysler Corpora-

tion's commitment to create a totally new family-sized vehicle using the latest design and production technologies. It's called "world class quality."

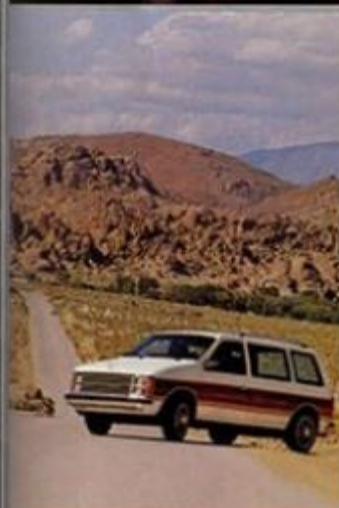
Caravan was almost completely designed through the use of computers in a process called CAD (Computer-Aided Design). This allows Chrysler designers and engineers to create and observe complex components for appearance, volume, weight, and stress—all at a touch.

One result is Caravan's aerodynamic styling which produces the lowest drag coefficient (0.43) of any van/wagon produced by a domestic manufacturer. Because of aerodynamics alone, Caravan boasts about 10% better fuel economy than conventional vans.

Many production and testing procedures are controlled by computers, including the use of 120 precise robot welders. From the moment you first experience the 1984 Caravan, you know there's a quality difference that you can see, hear, and feel.

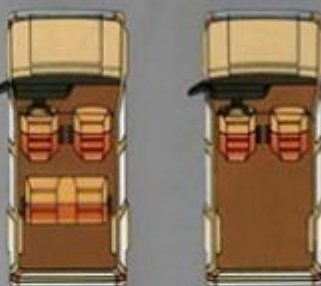
