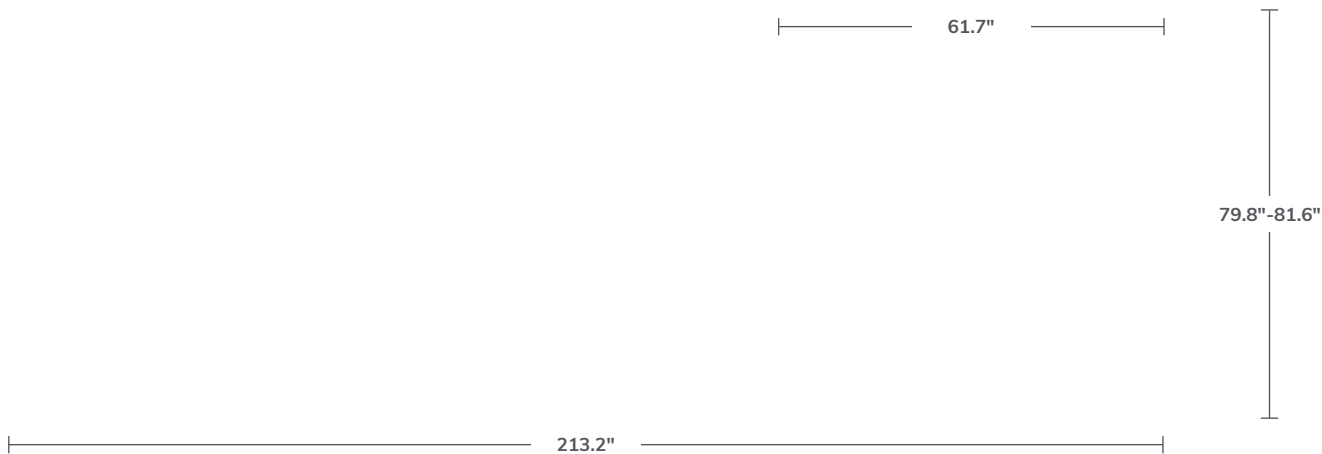

PROGRADE TRAILERING SYSTEM

GMC's available ProGrade Trailering System includes advanced technologies for increased confidence when towing a trailer. It helps when hooking up your trailer and while on the road with maintenance reminders, trailer electrical diagnostics, trailer theft detection¹ and more.

IN-VEHICLE TRAILERING APP²

The in-vehicle Trailering App² included with the available ProGrade Trailering System is integrated into Canyon's infotainment system³ and includes the ability to create five defined trailer profiles based on trailer name, trailer type and trailer hitch type. There are also maintenance reminders, a predeparture checklist, a Trailer Light Sequence Test and a counter for trailer mileage and fuel economy.

myGMC MOBILE APP⁴

The available myGMC Mobile App⁴ allows you to create and manage trailer profiles (shareable with other compatible Canyon owners), run Trailer Light Sequence Tests to help ensure trailer lights are in working order and reference a predeparture checklist. You can view and receive alerts on key components of your trailer such as trailer miles. There's also a glossary filled with trailering-related materials.

HITCH VIEW AND HITCH GUIDANCE

This standard trailering-assistance technology helps when backing up to a trailer. Hitch View⁵ displays a zoomed-in view of the hitch area to assist with aligning the vehicle's hitch ball with the trailer coupler and monitoring the trailer connection.

In addition, Hitch Guidance⁵ displays a single centered guidance line on the infotainment display to assist in aligning the vehicle's hitch with a trailer coupler. When driving, it allows you to check your trailer using the Rear Vision Camera view.⁵

IMPORTANT TERMS

CURB WEIGHT

The weight of a vehicle with all of the standard and optional equipment and a full tank of fuel, but without any passengers or cargo.

GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT (GVW)

The combined weight of the vehicle and all passengers and cargo.

GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR)

This number is the maximum amount a tow vehicle may weigh. Everything that contributes to the weight of the tow vehicle is featured in this rating, including the weight of the vehicle, driver and all passengers, fuel, payload, tongue load of the trailer, the weight of the hitch and all optional equipment. The GVWR is displayed on the driver's door or door-lock pillar label of your GMC vehicle. The GVW must never exceed the GVWR.

GROSS COMBINED WEIGHT (GCW)

The GVW plus the loaded trailer weight.

GROSS COMBINED WEIGHT RATING (GCWR)

The total allowable weight of the completely loaded vehicle and trailer, including any fuel, passengers, cargo, equipment and accessories.

CARGO WEIGHT

The weight of all items added to the curb weight of the vehicle, including cargo and optional equipment. When towing, cargo weight also includes the trailer tongue or hitch weight.

MAX PAYLOAD

The maximum allowable weight of passengers plus cargo that the vehicle is designed to carry.

GROSS AXLE WEIGHT (GAW)

The total weight placed on a single axle (front or rear).

GROSS AXLE WEIGHT RATING (GAWR)

This is the weight that each axle is capable of supporting. The load on each axle must not exceed the GAWR. The GAWR for each GMC vehicle is displayed on the driver's door or door-lock pillar label.

GROSS TRAILER WEIGHT

The weight of a loaded trailer.

TONGUE (OR HITCH) WEIGHT

The tongue weight is the total amount of trailer weight that is pressing down on the trailer hitch. Keep in mind that the way a trailer is loaded affects the overall tongue weight and will also affect the handling of the tow vehicle when trailering.

TRAILER HITCH TYPES

SELECTING THE RIGHT HITCH

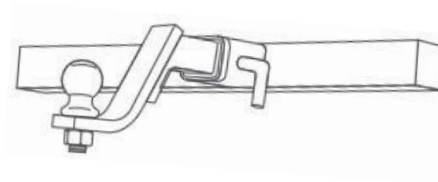
Choosing the right hitch, while ensuring proper electrical connections are made, affects how your vehicle handles, corners and brakes, and allows you to alert other drivers of your intentions. Before selecting a hitch or trailering package, you should be familiar with the weight ratings specific to your GMC vehicle.

WEIGHT-CARRYING HITCH

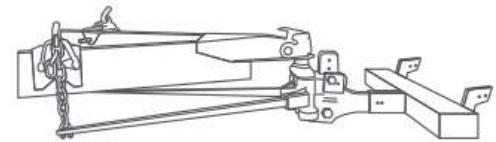
This consists of a hitch ball mounted on a step bumper or draw bar, or a tow eye latched to a pintle hook. Hitch balls are available in a range of sizes. Make sure that the diameter of your hitch ball matches your trailer coupler. Also check that the ball and ball mount meet or exceed the Gross Trailer Weight Rating.

WEIGHT-DISTRIBUTING HITCH
