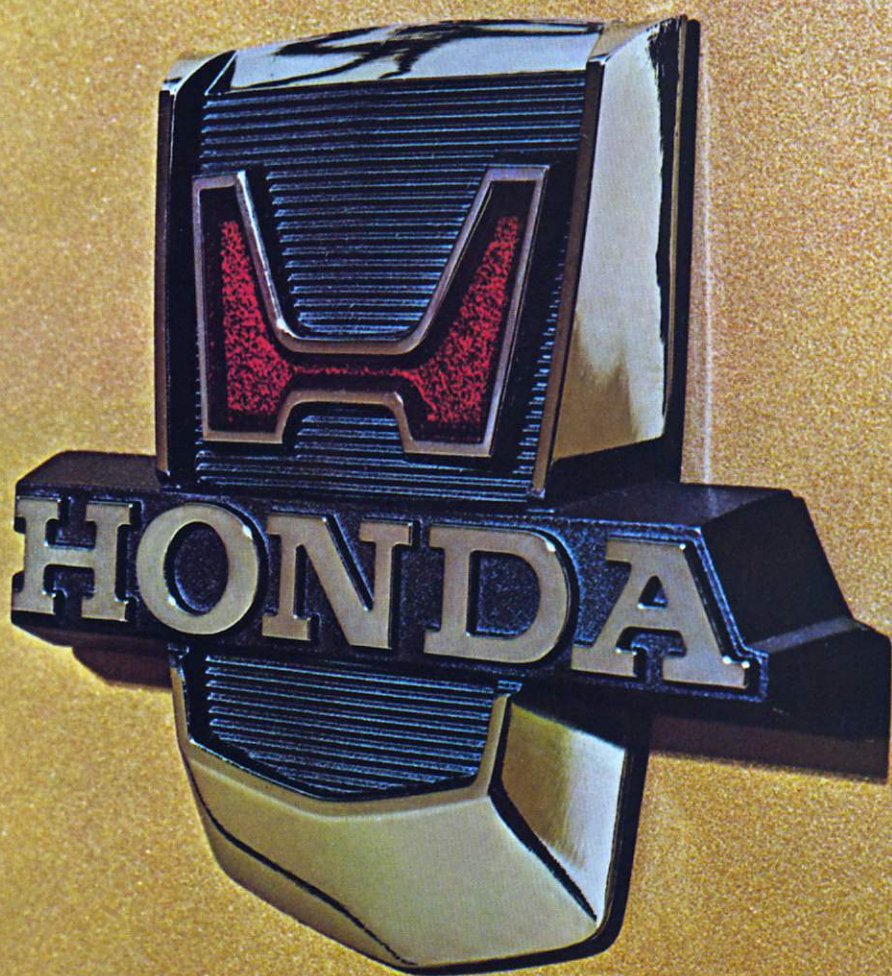

Cars Designed for Today: The Honda Civic Sedan and Hatchback

The Honda Civic was engineered from scratch for today's kind of driving. It's remarkable. Start with the Honda 1237cc single overhead cam engine. It doesn't need a catalytic converter, and it runs on regular, low-lead or no-lead gas.

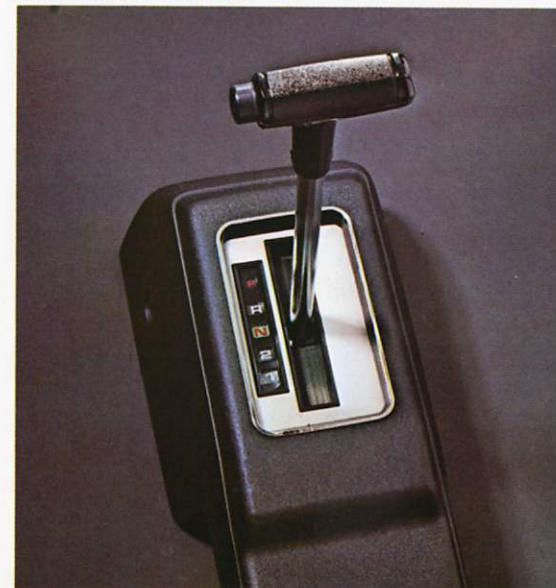
Notice the Honda Civic design. The engine is mounted sideways, so there's more room on the inside and with front-wheel drive there's no transmission hump. Inside, the Honda Civic holds four adults and luggage, too. In the Hatchback model, the rear seat folds down for even more carrying space.

Plus there's the standard engineering features on a Civic—features that many cars don't have: Rack and pinion steering, front-wheel drive, four wheel independent MacPherson Strut suspension, and a power-assisted dual-diagonal braking system with front disc brakes.

Then there's the locking fuel filler door, front mud guards, full interior carpeting, hinged rear side windows, tinted glass, adjustable reclining front bucket seats, and simulated wood dash trim. Plus whitewall tires and an AM radio on the Hatchback. Nice things to have on a car. Standard on the Honda Civic.

Inside, the Honda Civic is as innovative as it is outside.

Start with room. Because the Civic has front-wheel drive, there's no driveshaft tunnel to take up valuable interior space. So there's room enough for four adults and luggage. In the Hatchback, the rear seat folds down to provide even more carrying space.

The Honda Civic gives you standard features that some others charge extra for. Like full interior carpeting, tinted glass, adjustable reclining front bucket seats, hinged rear side windows, and simulated wood dash trim. And in the Hatchback, you also get an AM radio and whitewall tires. Standard.

There's even a way to simplify your driving: Two levers on the steering column that turn on and dim the headlights, operate the turn signals, and control the two-speed wipers and washer.

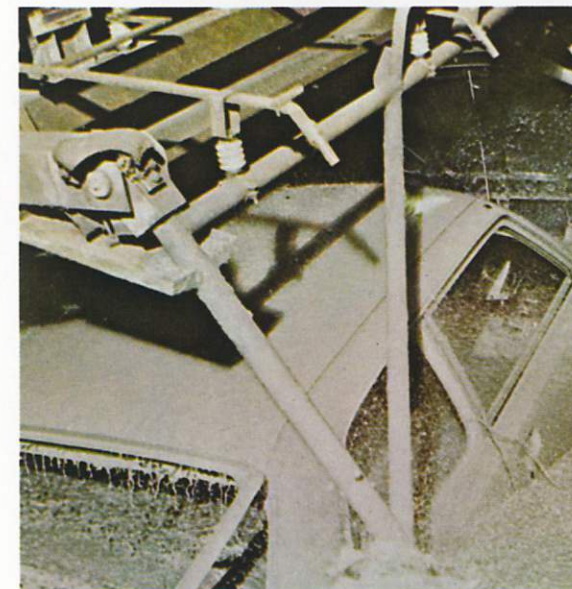
