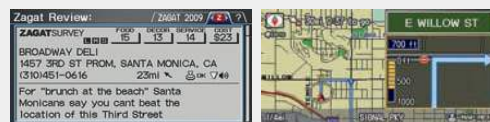

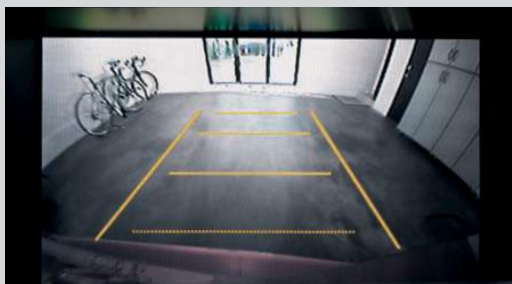

Every Crosstour features a 360-watt audio system with 7 speakers and a 6-disc in-dash CD changer. The EX-L adds XM[®] Radio⁴ and USB Audio Interface⁵. Plug in your compatible player or flash drive filled with music files, and the Crosstour displays song and folder information.

On navigation-equipped models, the system's screen can also help give you a look at what's behind you. Shift into reverse, and the rearview camera with an innovative guideline display makes it easier for you to maneuver the Crosstour when backing up.



When Honda designs a thoroughly new vehicle like the Accord Crosstour, it's a given that you'll find some of today's smartest technologies. The Crosstour's *Bluetooth*^{®6} HandsFreeLink[®] (EX-L) easily interfaces with your compatible mobile phone,⁶ so you can make calls without taking your hands off the wheel.

The power moonroof opens with a single touch. The overhead console is also the control center for the HomeLink^{®7} system (EX-L). It can be programmed to operate up to three remote-controlled devices, such as garage-door openers and home security systems.

Need more space? Just flip down the 60/40 split rear seatback. It's an easy one-handed task that can be done from the rear doors or from the rear cargo area, thanks to the cleverly located levers.



With the rear seatback folded, the Crosstour offers more than 51 cubic feet of cargo space.¹ So bring all your toys. Think of it as the new way to do utility.

GET **FOUR-WHEELED CONTROL** AND CONFIDENCE

The Accord Crosstour can analyze the G-forces being exerted on the vehicle, and its transmission will hold a gear accordingly through a turn for enhanced driving stability.

The available Real Time 4WD system provides added confidence when the weather takes a turn. When traveling down a snowy, wet road—or practically any low-traction surface—the system can detect a loss of traction. It can then automatically send power to the rear wheels to help keep you on course and underway.

A double wishbone front and multi-link rear suspension offer predictable handling and a smooth ride. The front shocks feature a specially designed rebound spring within the shock tube that enhances front tire contact with the road when cornering.

Even though the Crosstour has a high, commanding presence, its center of gravity is notably low. Honda engineers achieved this by placing the engine, transmission and fuel tank as low as possible in the chassis. The results can be felt in how well the Crosstour handles.

POWER, OR EFFICIENCY?
THE MODERN ANSWER: YES

Honda's Variable Cylinder Management™ (VCM®) technology can activate and deactivate cylinders as needed to provide brisk acceleration while maximizing fuel efficiency.⁹

When maximum power and torque are required, six cylinders are firing. The transition between the three VCM modes is nearly seamless to driver and passengers.

During steady cruising, the rear bank of cylinders is deactivated for increased fuel efficiency.⁹ In this mode, Active Sound Control helps cancel out unwanted harmonics.

As cruising speed increases, the engine moves from 3-cylinder to 4-cylinder mode. Active engine mounts help keep engine vibration from reaching the cabin.

SAFETY FOR EVERYONE

Making advanced safety features standard is more than a goal. It's a philosophy.

The Accord Crosstour has an Advanced Compatibility Engineering™ (ACE™) body structure. This Honda-exclusive design enhances occupant protection and crash compatibility in frontal collisions. By dispersing crash energy more evenly throughout the front of the vehicle, less force is transmitted to the passenger compartment.

To help reduce the likelihood of whiplash injuries, the front seats have active head restraints. They move up and forward in a rear collision.

The Crosstour's standard front, front side and side curtain airbags* can help reduce the likelihood of injuries in a collision.

The side curtain airbags also feature a sensor that can detect a rollover, and will then deploy those airbags appropriately. The front passenger's side airbag uses the Occupant Position Detection System (OPDS) to help prevent deployment if a small-statured passenger is out of position and in the airbag's path of deployment.

Outboard rear seats have the LATCH (Lower Anchors and Tethers for CHildren) child-restraint system.

All five passengers benefit from 3-point seat belts. And the front seat belts are equipped with an automatic tensioning system that will tighten in a moderate-to-severe frontal impact.

The Crosstour's Tire Pressure Monitoring System™ (TPMS) will notify the driver when air pressure is significantly low.

Standard ABS helps you maintain steering—even during hard braking. Brake Assist can help the driver apply full braking in some emergency situations, and Electronic Brake Distribution (EBD) helps braking performance by distributing brake force among the wheels based on how much load each wheel is bearing.
