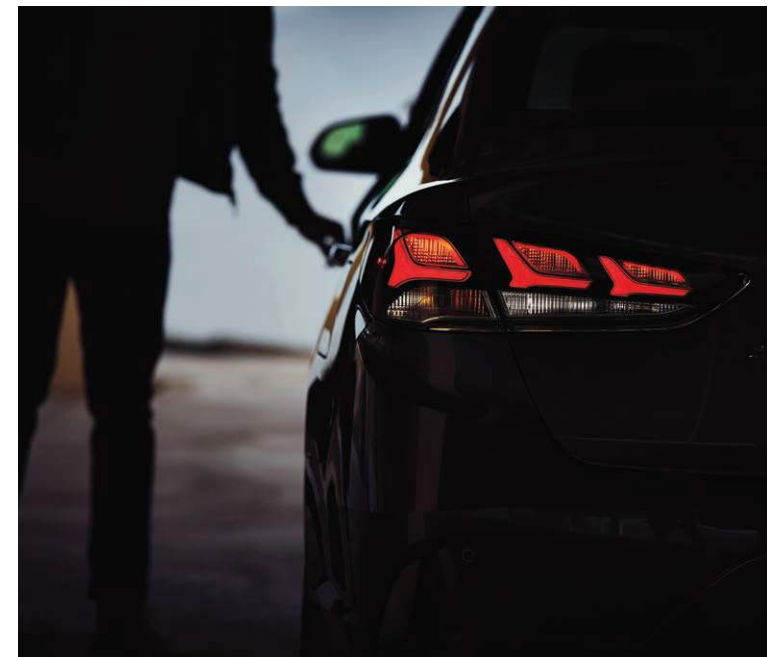

Performance Engineering

For the performance-minded among you, our new Sonata takes some exciting turns.

With their stiff suspensions, sporty sedans have always sacrificed some measure of ride comfort to give the driver a better feel for the road. But in the new Sonata, Hyundai engineers have found a better way. With a recalibrated steering system and new rear suspension design, Sonata delivers a win-win – handling that's more precise without compromising ride comfort.

It's a new level of driving calm and confidence that also delivers the maneuverability of a 35.6-foot turning radius – the tightest in its class.¹ And all of that twin-scroll turbo thrust on Sonata 2.0T models? It's matched by a sport-tuned suspension, the stopping power of larger-diameter front disc brakes and a new, silky-smooth 8-speed automatic transmission that generates better acceleration off the line with improved fuel efficiency at higher speeds.

To signal their sportier character, the Sonata Sport, Sport 2.0T and Limited 2.0T models feature unique design cues like vertical LED Daytime Running Lights, a cascading mesh grille, a rear air diffuser and a dual chrome-tipped exhaust. Step inside the Sport 2.0T or Limited 2.0T, and performance-inspired details are all around you. Check out the leather-wrapped, flat-bottom steering wheel with paddle shifters, sport seats with leather side bolsters, and aluminum pedals. And notice how your pulse gets elevated, even before you take your first turn.



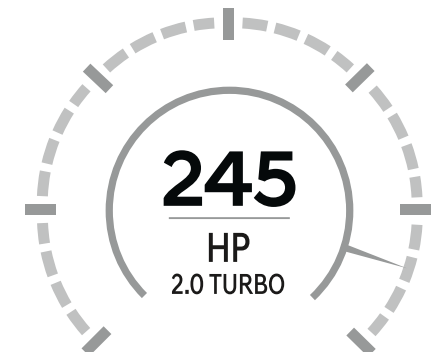
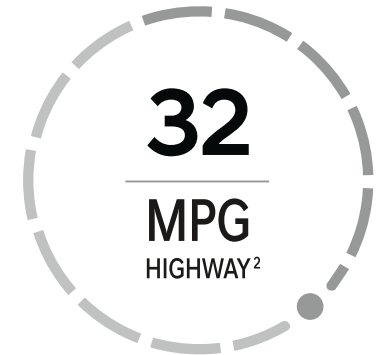

Paddle Like A Pro Sonata's new 8-speed SHIFTRONIC® transmission on Sport 2.0T and Limited 2.0T models uses steering wheel paddle shifters, a feature found on racecars. What are they doing on a Sonata? The same thing they do on racecars – triggering upshifts or downshifts without taking your hands off the steering wheel. Or your eyes off the road.

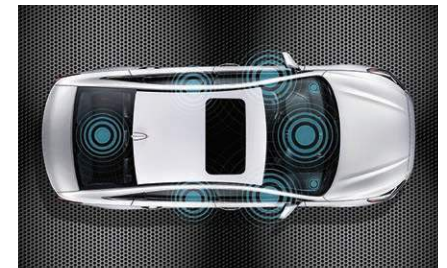

A Smarter Trunk What if you didn't need to fumble for your keys just to open the trunk? Sonata's segment-exclusive smart trunk opens automatically when it detects the key fob in your pocket or purse. Simply wait by the trunk for a few seconds, and it opens with no need to wave one foot awkwardly under the rear bumper like some competing systems require.³

Advanced Safety

The new Sonata raises the standards for safety among midsize sedans.

At Hyundai, we didn't earn the most brand-loyal customers in the automotive industry for eight consecutive years by being followers. Our customers expect us to lead – especially when it comes to safety. That's why the 2018 Sonata is the first car in its class to make safety innovations like Blind Spot Detection, Rear Cross-traffic Alert and Lane Change Assist standard on every model.¹ We've made other advanced safety technologies available as well, including Automatic Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection² and Lane Departure Warning with a new Lane Keep Assist function.³

In doing so, we're helping Sonata drivers be more aware of their surroundings by alerting them to the potential for collisions before they happen – and actively engaging in certain circumstances if a forward collision appears imminent. The new Sonata's crash protection starts with a body made of 51 percent advanced high-strength steel components, and also includes 7 standard airbags: dual front, side, and curtain...as well as a driver's knee airbag.⁴ Do we expect other midsize sedans to follow our lead and make more safety innovations standard? For everyone's benefit, we sincerely hope so.

Turn Here Conventional headlights project straight ahead. But roads aren't necessarily straight, are they? On the new Sonata Limited and Sonata Limited 2.0T, LED headlights with Dynamic Bending Light turn the headlight beams in sync with the steering wheel for better visibility when cornering.



Back Up, Calm Down Nearly a quarter of all auto accidents involve a vehicle that's backing up.⁵ Thankfully, the new Sonata comes standard with Rear Cross-traffic Alert. It helps warn you of vehicles approaching from the side when reverse gear is selected. A rearview camera with dynamic guidelines also helps you back out of tight parking spaces.



Parking Made Easier For 2018, Sonata Limited is available with rear parking sensors.⁶ Located in Sonata's rear bumper, they help determine if you're getting too close to a rear obstruction. If so, audible and visual warnings alert the driver. A wide-angle image is also displayed on the audio/navigation screen at low parking speeds.

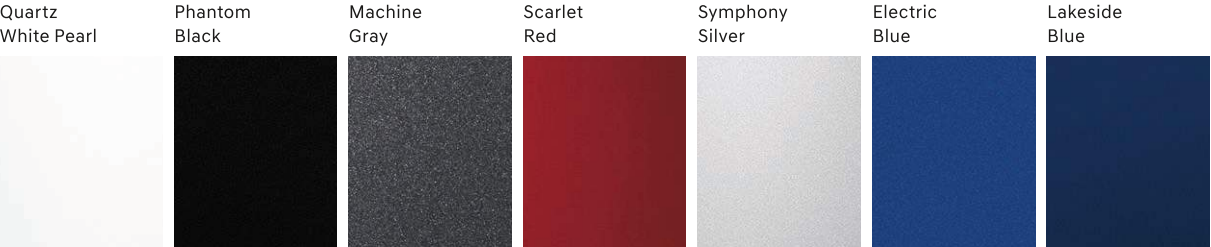
