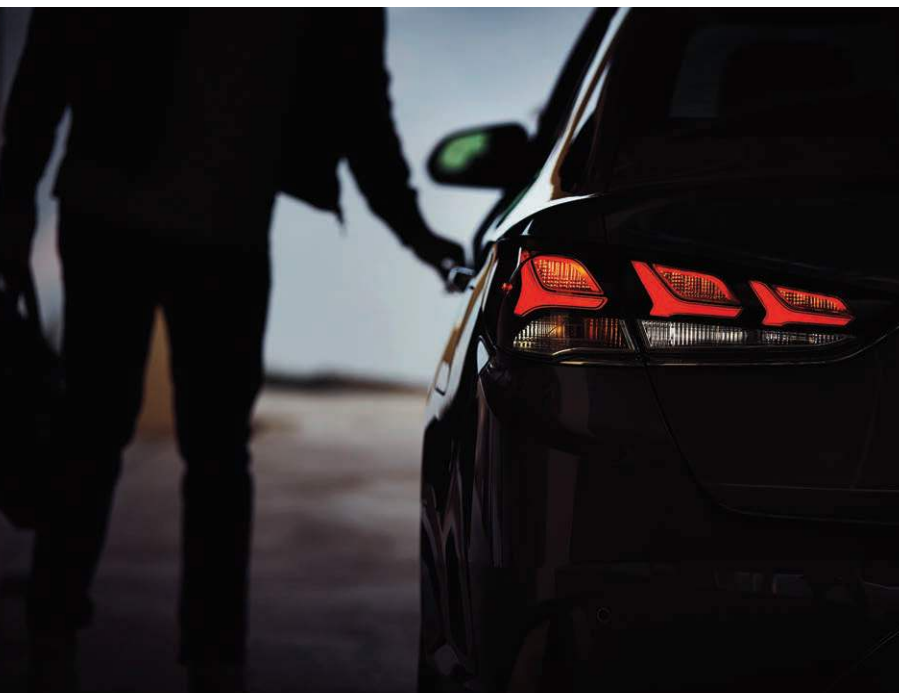

The 2019 Sonata SE's 2.4L engine and 6-speed SHIFTRONIC® automatic transmission balance smooth power with spirited responsiveness. Sonata Eco's 1.6L turbo engine is synced with a quick-shifting 7-speed Dual Clutch Transmission, producing more horsepower and torque than the 2018 Chevrolet Malibu 1.5T and Volkswagen Passat 2.0T – with better fuel economy than many subcompacts and econoboxes.¹ Our top-of-the-line Sonata Limited 2.0T couples an advanced twin-scroll turbocharger with an 8-speed SHIFTRONIC® automatic transmission for 245-horsepower performance that *Automobile* described as “a home run for the sedan world” during their first drive of the 2018 Sonata 2.0T.²

No matter which Sonata you choose, an innovation called Drive Mode Select lets you tailor it even more precisely to your requirements. Simply decide your priority – comfort, fuel economy or a sporty feel – and Drive Mode Select recalibrates the engine, transmission and steering response to reflect your wishes. Sonata 2.0T models even include a Smart setting that analyzes your driving and automatically adjusts to the mode that seems to suit you. Who knew being so practical could get you exactly what you wanted?

Turns For The Better

Hyundai engineers calibrated the Sonata's steering and rear suspension to deliver handling that's more precise – without compromising ride comfort. A 35.6-foot turning radius – the tightest in its class¹ – also adds exceptional maneuverability in U-turns and tight parking lots.

Paradigm Shifts

The 2019 Sonata 2.0T's 8-speed transmission helps deliver extra off-the-line acceleration, smooth shifting and a more fuel-efficient dash down the interstate. Sonata Eco's dual clutches work in tandem to create instantaneous gear shifts and boost fuel economy through improved efficiency.

Slippery Shape

Sonata's sleek design is inspired by the shape of America's Cup catamaran hulls that glide above choppy waves with stability and ultra-responsive speed. This has produced an aerodynamic 0.27 coefficient of drag that improves fuel efficiency and helps reduce wind noise.

The fuel-saving power behind the 2019 Sonata Hybrid and Plug-in Hybrid is Hyundai Blue Drive® technology, which seamlessly switches power between a gasoline direct-injection engine and a powerful electric motor. What makes Sonata hybrids so special is how quietly this transfer of power is handled: It's smooth and virtually imperceptible, preserving the serenity you expect from a comfortable, luxuriously appointed sedan.

Sonata Plug-in Hybrid's primary charge energy is preserved by a state-of-the-art lithium-ion polymer battery with more power – and a longer driving range – compared to the conventional battery systems used by some competing hybrids.¹ On the road, you'll enjoy an estimated 28-mile All-Electric Range,² an estimated 600-mile total range (when the gasoline engine and electric motor work together),² and an estimated efficiency rating of 99 MPGe in electric mode with 39 MPG combined in hybrid mode.² It's a technology so impressive, it led to Sonata being the first plug-in hybrid ever named to the Wards 10 Best Engines list.³

Behind the wheel, you'll enjoy how precise Sonata Hybrid and Plug-in Hybrid's shifting feels versus the rubber-band sensation of some other hybrids' continuously variable transmissions. The suspension is a revelation, delivering responsive handling dynamics without sacrificing a smooth ride. Something else you'll appreciate: A class-exclusive Lifetime Hybrid Battery Warranty.¹

Sonata Plug-in Hybrid's 9.8 kWh battery system is the ideal size for optimizing both extended EV driving and time to charge. A 240V charger takes less than 3 hours to recharge. Using a 120V outlet takes less than 9 hours, perfect for overnight charging.

Better Regenerative Braking

In some hybrids, the regenerative braking that recharges your car's battery creates an oddly unsettling feel underfoot. But Sonata hybrids are different. Press the brake pedal, and the response that you feel is pleasantly smooth and linear. Just the way it should be.

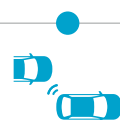

Sonata was the first car in its class to make safety innovations like Blind Spot Detection, Lane Change Assist and Rear Cross-traffic Alert standard on every model.¹ Sonata Limited's available rear parking sensors have also got your back with audible and visual warnings that alert you when obstructions get too close.²

It's all part of Hyundai's advanced active safety systems, an arsenal that includes available Lane Keep Assist and Automatic Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection.³ All designed to help Sonata drivers by alerting them to the potential for collisions before they happen – and actively engaging in preventative safety measures if a collision appears imminent.

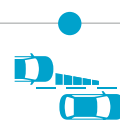

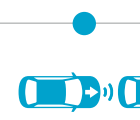

A Brighter Idea

Conventional headlights project straight ahead. But roads aren't always straight. Which is why all Sonata Limited models feature LED headlights with Dynamic Bending Light that turns your headlight beams in sync with the steering wheel for better visibility in and around corners.⁵

Back Up, Calm Down

Nearly one quarter of all auto accidents today involve a car that's backing up.⁶ Thankfully, Sonata comes standard with Rear Cross-traffic Alert. It helps warn of vehicles approaching from the side when you are backing out of parking spaces in reverse gear.

A Brain For Lanes

When a vehicle in front slows, Sonata's available Smart Cruise Control automatically reduces your speed. It can even slow to a stop and restart automatically.⁷ Lane Keep Assist's corrective steering assistance helps you avoid drifting outside of your driving lane unintentionally.

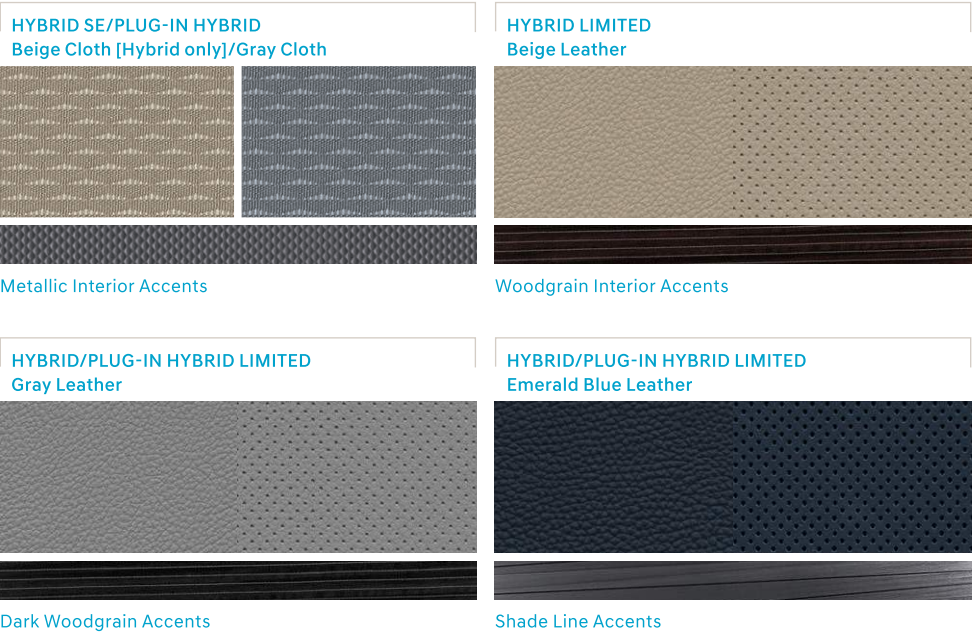
