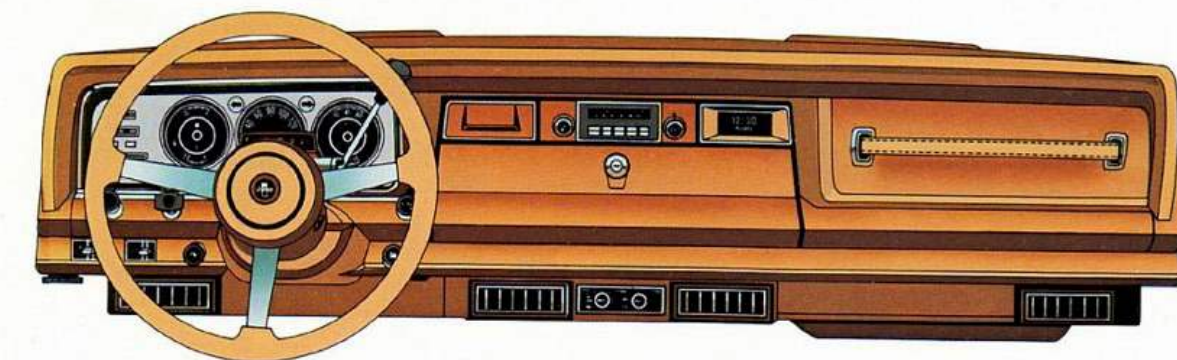

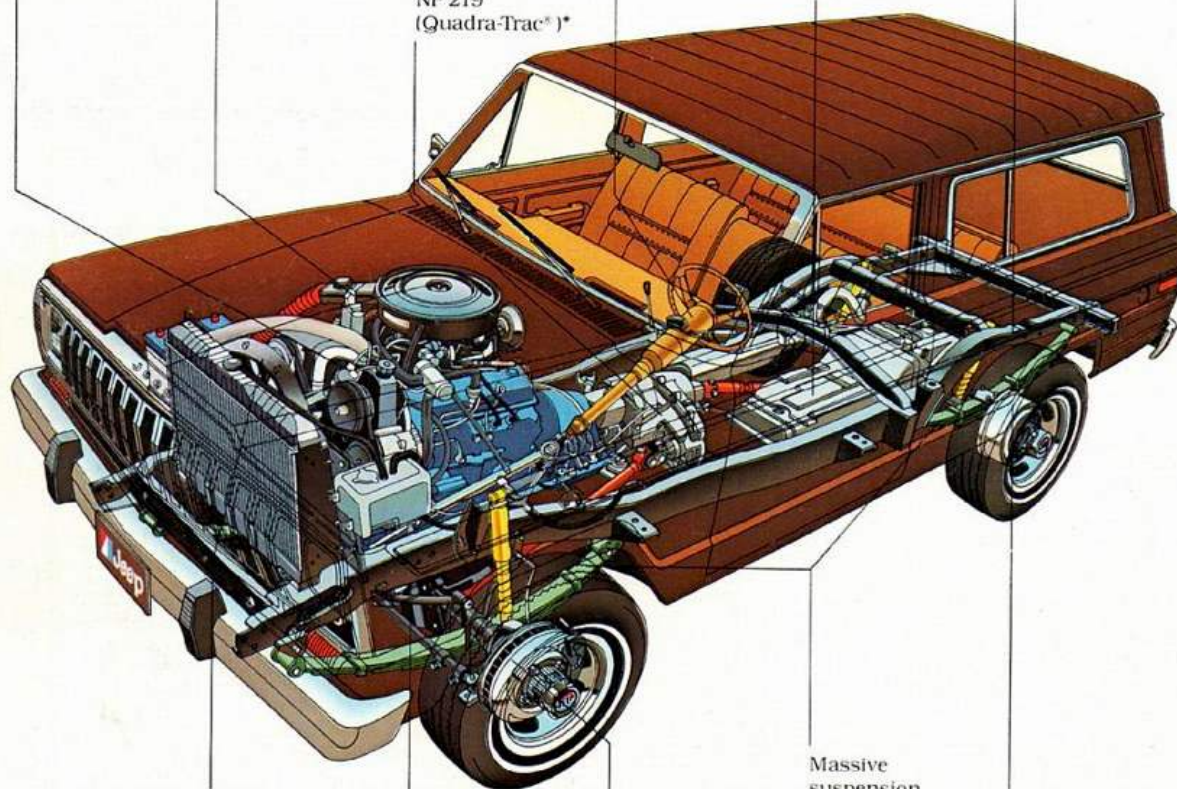

Durability

Every Jeep Cherokee is designed and built to function well and last under extreme conditions. Durability is built-in, starting with engineering that stresses proven mechanical components and resistance to the corrosive effects of all-condition usage.

Frame and suspension parts are massive and designed for off-road use. Vulnerable areas such as the fuel tank and lines are protected by a steel skid plate. Care and

attention have been given to improving corrosion resistance of critical sheet metal panels. For example, one- or two-sided galvanized steel has been used to form front side sills, lower quarter panels, body hinge pillars, lower body rocker panels, inner and outer wheelhouse panels, front and rear fenders, taillamp mounting plates, inner and outer tailgate and door panels and cowl top ventilator grille. Hot waxes are

applied in hard-to-paint boxed sections on each vehicle. After painting, the body is baked to thoroughly bond the paint to the body surfaces. Even frame and suspension parts are heavily coated to minimize corrosion.

The world of the 4-wheel drive vehicle is a harsh one. Jeep Cherokee, from the ground up, is constructed in the tradition of every Jeep ever made – strong, dependable, and proud.

The original Jeep® was conceived and built to do the work of war. Tough, hard, dirty work, with little time to be spared on tricky maintenance. Today's Jeep Cherokee remains true to that heritage of durability and dependability and benefits from 40 years of continuous 4-wheel drive development by Jeep Corporation.

If you need a rugged, dependable 4-wheel drive utility vehicle, Jeep Cherokee is the answer. Engineered and built to endure the extreme conditions expected of a working tool, Cherokees are built with a massive frame which supports the world's most sophisticated, yet rugged, drivetrain and suspension. The frame is of welded and riveted construction so it can flex and not break under heavy use. The heavy gauge body panels are simple in shape, stamped with reinforcements, precision mounted to the frame, and thickly coated with corrosion inhibitors. Another measure of the dependable character and durability of Jeep Cherokee is the fact that 96% of all Jeep vehicles built in the last 10 years are still on the road in the U.S. And, to help insure that your Cherokee conforms to Jeep Corporation's exacting quality standards, every Jeep vehicle undergoes a 162-point inspection at the factory.

Cherokees come in 2-door, 2-door wide-wheel and 4-door models with a choice of engine and transmission combinations. 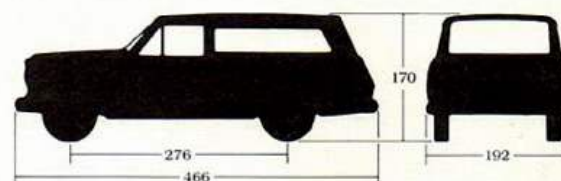
