



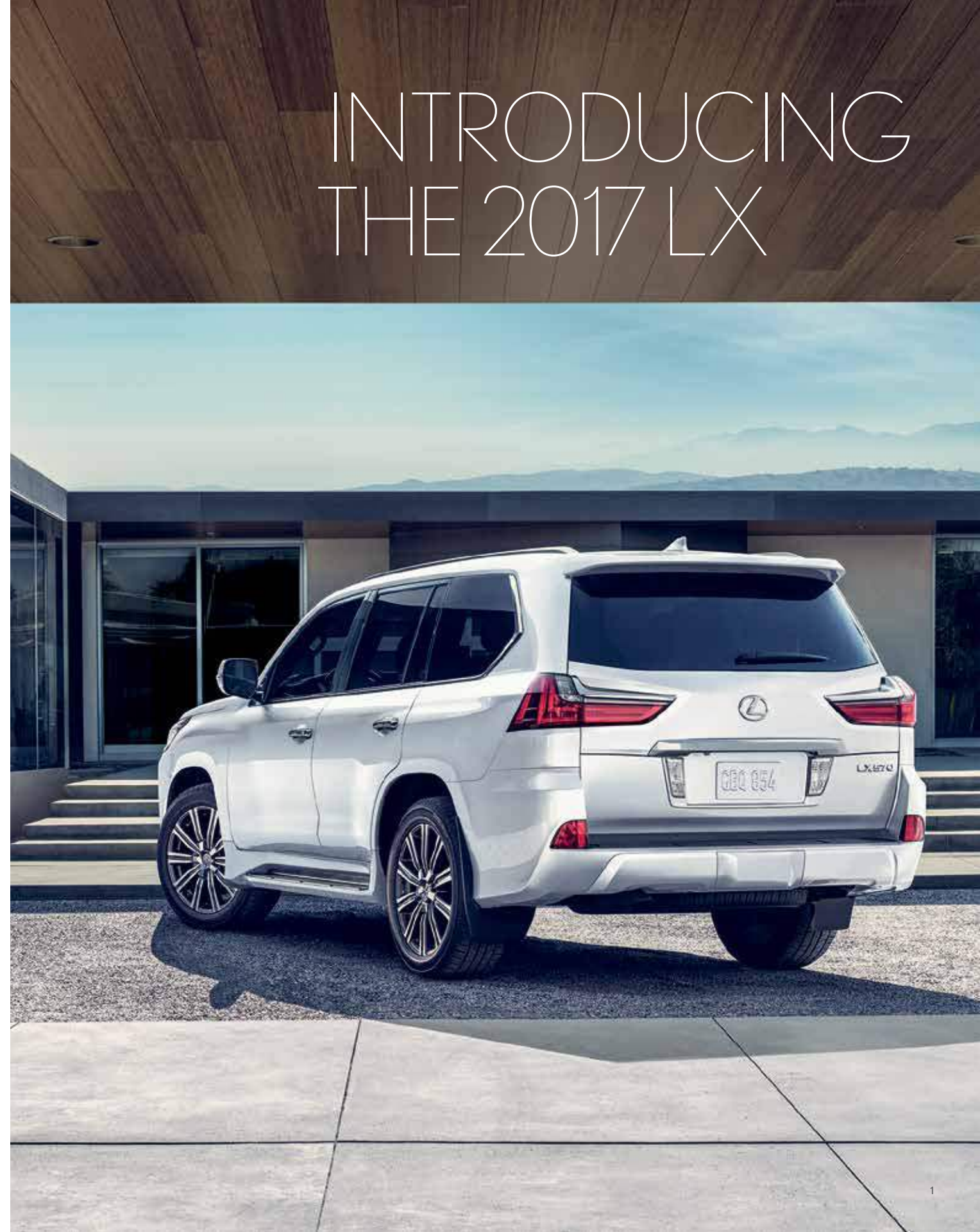

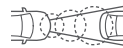

PRE-COLLISION SYSTEM WITH PEDESTRIAN DETECTION

The Pre-Collision System (PCS)¹⁶ with Pedestrian Detection¹⁷ is engineered to detect vehicles in the path of your Lexus under certain conditions. 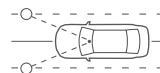

In addition, power is automatically shifted to the wheels with the most traction.

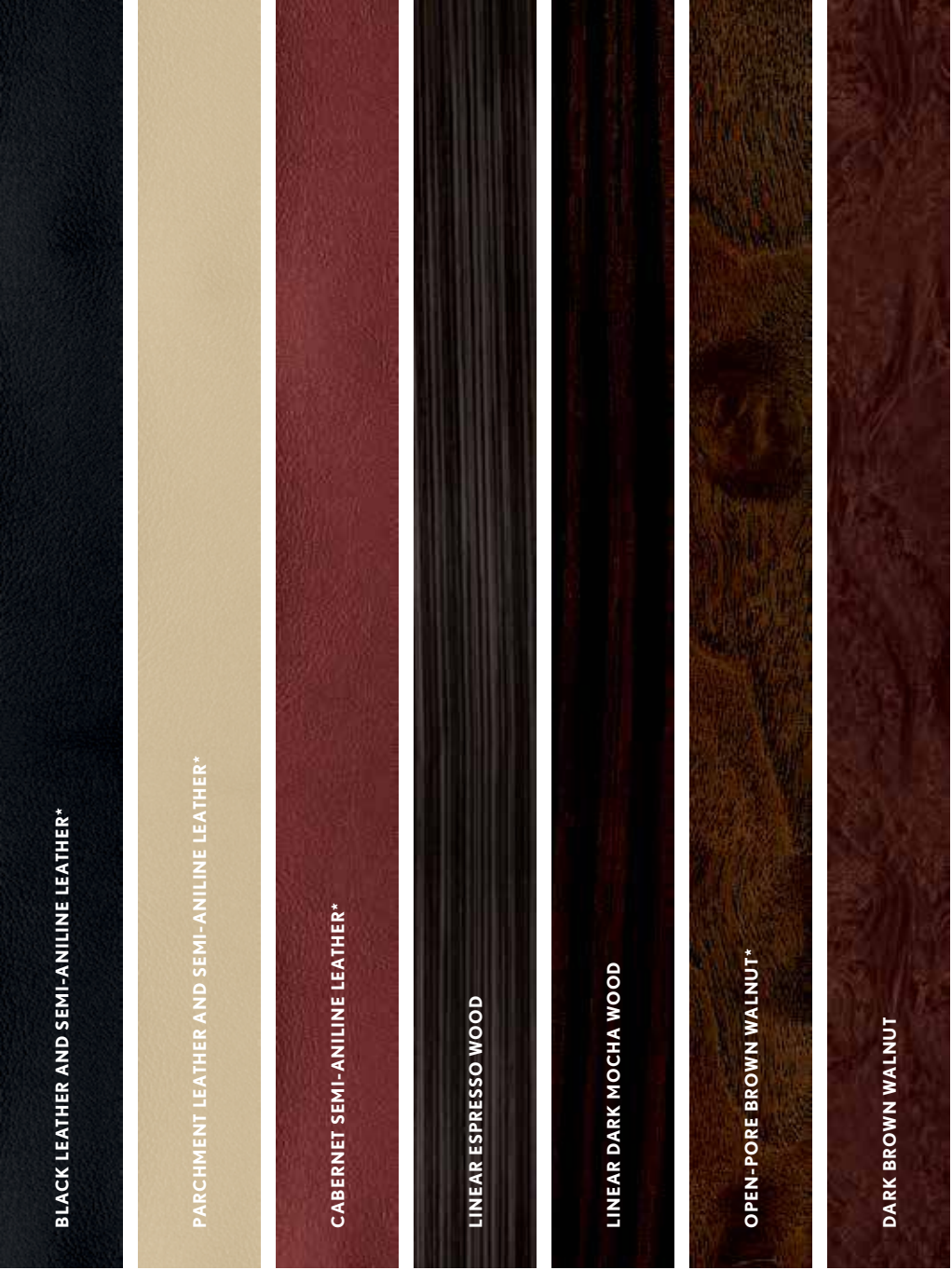
