Rich, simulated wood-grain inserts are used to



highlight the Satellite Sebring instrument panel. The door trim panels also feature a simulated wood appliqué. Complete gauges, rather than warning lights, in the panel keep you informed of what's happening. All standard.

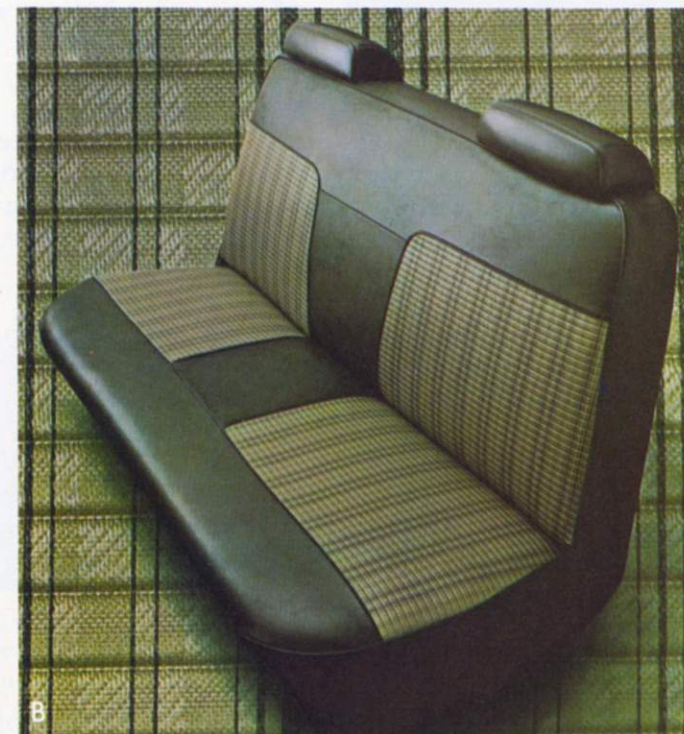

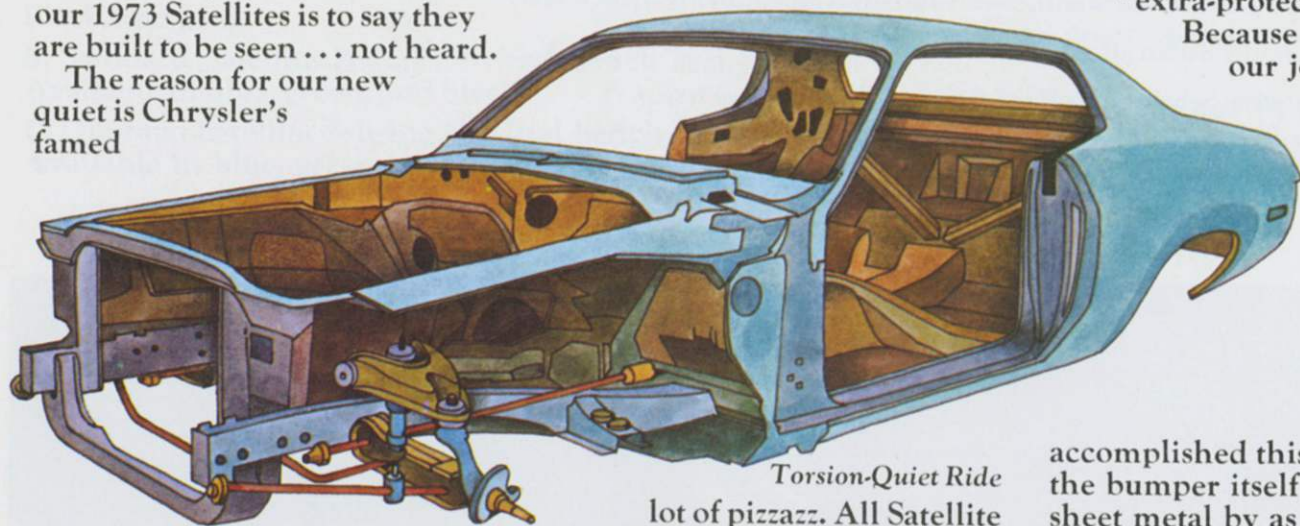

The reason for our new quiet is Chrysler's famed

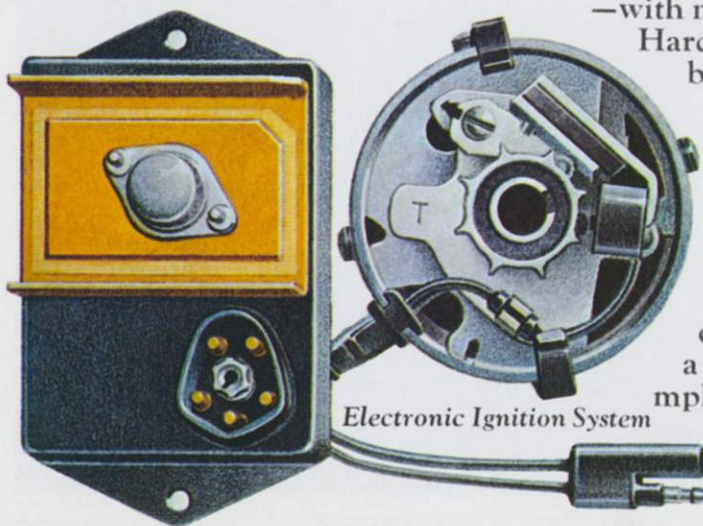


Torsion-Quiet Ride. A unique combination of front torsion-bar suspension, unibody construction and sound isolators. The result is a quiet, controlled riding experience.

Every new Satellite has Torsion-Quiet Ride. And the Sebring-Plus has even more sound-reducing features. It's one of our "Super-Quiet" cars for '73. Included are sound deadeners and silencers in the floor, luggage compartment, door trim panels, steering column, exhaust system, rear wheel-housings and rear shelf panel.

These additions make this year's Satellite Sebring-Plus the quietest intermediate-size car ever built by Plymouth.

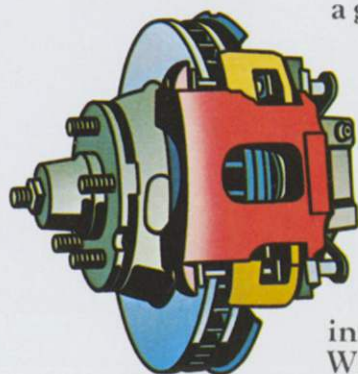

a good look at the Satellite sedans and hardtops, you'll see that they are distinctly different in style.

When we set out to build the kind of car America wants, we felt that two different body types deserved two different kinds of design and styling.

The result is two different looks for the sedan and hardtops—with no compromising.

Hardtop and sedan buyers can each have a car just right for their particular needs. Our engineers have designed an extra-protection bumper system capable of impacting a fixed barrier at 5 mph in the front and 2½ mph in the rear without significant damage to any

portion of the car.

Why do we call these bumpers "extra-protection?"

Because we've done our job in meeting or exceeding the federal government's new damage standards for low-speed accidents.

Some of the ways we accomplished this are by setting the bumper itself out from the sheet metal by as much as two inches to provide impact protection, and by locating a full-width reinforcement behind the bumper surface to provide increased beam strength during impact. There's also a bumper support structure using heavy-gauge steel with deep sections. In addition to their impact capabilities, the elastomeric bumper guards help keep your 1973 Satellite from slipping over or under another car's bumper during a low-speed impact.

We've also built in protection for your car with an ignition key warning buzzer and an anti-theft steering column lock. In addition, all Satellites now have a new deck lid lock design that offers substantially increased resistance to illegal entry.

You also get an Electronic Ignition System standard. Compared to a conventional ignition system, Satellite's system is a hands-down winner. For example, there are no points or condenser. So you may never have to worry about periodic ignition tune-ups. Your original engine timing should be good for 50,000 miles or more.

Excluding routine spark plug service, the system is virtually maintenance free.



Trailer-Towing Package

You also get a consistently higher voltage—by as much as 35%—for more dependable starts even in cold and damp weather. Electronic ignition helps eliminate many of the major causes of an engine misfiring, thus reducing engine emissions caused by a weak spark.

Emissions are further reduced by an

electric assist choke, which consists of a heater element in the automatic choke well to shorten the

period of choke operation.

On Satellite, Satellite Custom and Satellite Sebring models you have a choice of either a 225 Six or a 318 V-8.

On Satellite Sebring-Plus and Road Runner models the 318 V-8 is the standard engine.

All Satellite engines are capable of running on regular, low-lead, or no-lead gas.

Optional engines are the 400 cu. in. V-8 (2- and 4-barrel

versions) for all models plus the 340 and 440 V-8 for the Road Runner.

Satellite's standard transmission is a 3-speed manual that's been improved to reduce shift effort. Front disc brakes are standard, too. If you want, add an optional power booster to them.

Another popular option for Satellite is the legendary Torque Flite transmission.

For 1973, we've improved our TorqueFlite with a new hydrodynamic front pump seal. There's also a new transmission fluid filter that provides a 50% increase in filtering area to lengthen the life of both fluid and transmission.

Other options include air conditioning, vinyl roof, new AM/FM monaural or AM/FM stereo radio, and a sun roof. This modestly priced, factory-installed, sliding metal sun roof is manually operated. It's available on all



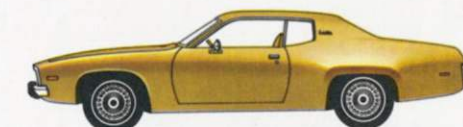

2-door models—with or without a vinyl roof.

Or you may wish to have our optional trailer-towing package. With it, your Satellite can tow up to 6,000 pounds of boat, camper, or whatever you wish. For full details on trailer-towing, ask your dealer for our 1973 Trailer-Towing Guide.

We're committed to building the kind of car America wants. This means your '73 Satellite has a lot of little touches like all-nylon cut-pile carpeting for improved wear. Newly designed windshield wipers to minimize smearing and streaking. Easy operating door handles. A new combination heater/air conditioning control. And all instrument panel controls are fully illuminated.

protecting the environment. Our Cleaner Air System is a highly integrated emission control system that has evolved through engineering, to effectively reduce the level of automotive emissions. Emission controls for our '73 cars, as compared to cars having no emission controls, are as follows: Total hydrocarbons reduced by about 85%, carbon monoxide reduced by about 70%, and oxides of nitrogen by about 50%.

We've done all of these things because we feel this is the kind of car you want.

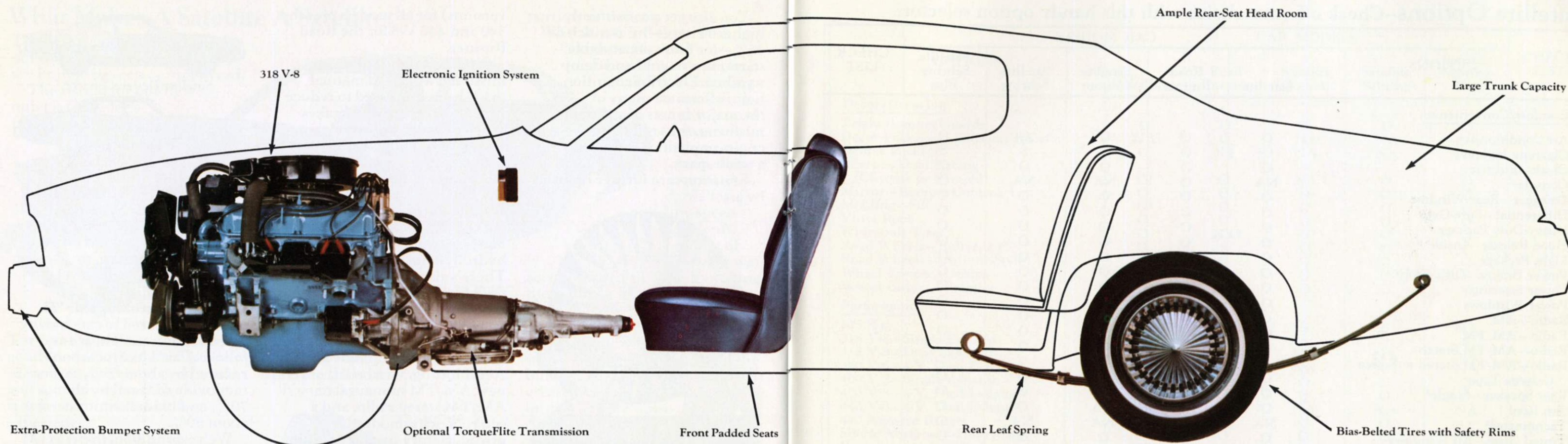

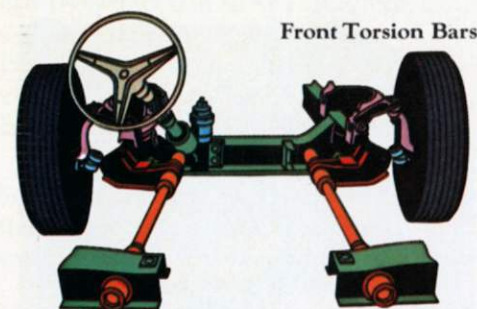

We've done a lot to make this year's Satellite one of the quietest mid-size cars on the road. To



achieve this, we put in an isolated suspension system and other sound-deadening components. The result is Chrysler's famed Torsion-Quiet Ride.

For 1973, both the front and rear suspensions on all our Satellite models are isolated to provide a quiet, smooth ride.

The front suspension, a new design, utilizes an isolated cross member separated from the body by six rubber isolators.

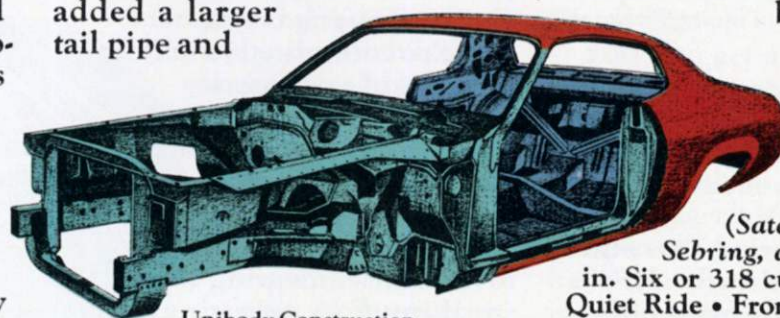
Front torsion bars twist to soften road shock and help to

smooth out bumpy roads.

Rubber surrounds the rear-leaf spring clamps to reduce vibration, road harshness and noise.

In addition, rubber bushings, spool-type engine mounts and a double coupling between the steering column and the steering gear cut down further on noise and vibration.

We've managed to make your 1973 Satellite quieter by the effective use of acoustical material. We've also added a larger tail pipe and



a retuned muffler to all 318 V-8's to reduce engine noise.

You can't unbolt a Satellite body from its frame, because

every Satellite is built the Unibody way. Our engineers believe that the over 4,000 welds we use make the car body tough and strong and help eliminate rattles.

To help stop rust before it starts, every Satellite body goes through our 7-step dip-and-spray process. Then our new acrylic dispersion enamel is used for the body exterior coat to make sure your car stays bright and shiny for a long time to come.
